and trails for Orangevale residents and consistently comes up with new ideas that he shares with staff.



# Virginia M Nielsen December 5, 1912 – May 22, 2017

Virginia Nielsen was born in Modesto 12/5/1912 to Charles and Ida Edwards. She grew up in what was then rural Modesto with older siblings Edith, Laverne, Charles, and younger brother Warren.

Virginia moved to San Francisco to pursue Nursing. She went to nursing school, and became an RN in the 1930's.

Virginia was a long time Orangevale resident. She moved to Orangevale in 1945 with her then husband Al Nielsen and son Kenneth, where they bought and operated a local chicken ranch; she remained in Orangevale for the rest of her life. In the late 1950's, she moved on to other jobs. She used to recall working at Capri market, and cashing checks for Buck Owens when he played locally. She eventually returned to nursing at Roseville Hospital in the maternity ward, until her retirement in 1977.

Virginia loved bowling. She bowled at Lake Bowl in Folsom for years; continuing into her later years using a lighter ball so she could still bowl even while using a walker. She traveled the western states and Hawaii with her 500 Club Team. She was bowling in Washington when Mount Saint Helens erupted; she brought home jars of ash. Even after she was confined to a wheelchair, she was an excellent Nintendo Wii bowler!

Virginia started voting as soon as she was old enough to do so. She was active as a polling place volunteer for almost 70 years. She volunteered for local, state, and federal elections. She was recognized by the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors for her years of service to the community. She recalled going with her mother to the polling place when women were given the right to vote.

Virginia loved working at the Farmers market, selling corn, and interacting with customers. When she was absent after she broke her leg, customers would ask about her. Although she was not able to return often after that, every time she went to the market she would greet old acquaintances. She would roll right up to the table, start selling corn and talking to folks.

Virginia is survived by her son Kenneth Nielsen, grandchildren Robert (Shilo), Susan (Randy) and Allan (Caitlin), and great grandchildren Ian, Cody, Hunter, and Aidan.



On an average day, the U.S. Coast Guard: conducts 45 search and rescue cases; saves 10 lives; saves over \$1.2M in property; conducts 57 waterborne patrols of critical maritime infrastructure; screens 360 merchant vessels for potential security threats prior to arrival in U.S. ports; conducts fisheries conservation boarding's; investigates pollution incidents; and facilitates movement of \$8.7B worth of goods and commodities through the Nation's Maritime Transportation System.

A couple months ago I wrote an article for the Orangevale View to discuss my opposition to the "gas tax" that was working its way through the California Legislature. Predictably that bill was signed into law shortly after my article was released, and since its passage, I have had more questions about the details of how this new law will impact Sacramento County than any other topic. So I want to take this opportunity to give you a status update and to dispel some misconceptions people may have.

First, let me explain exactly what the new law does. It raises the gas tax by another 12 cents per gallon, it hikes the vehicle license fee by over 50%, raises the cost of registering a vehicle by 80%, and more than doubles the diesel tax. Surely, with this much money being taken from the taxpayers the problem is going to be fixed, right? Wrong.

Sacramento County roadways are in critical condition, as I'm sure you can testify to as you play "avoid the pothole" as you drive to work every day. This is because our deferred maintenance costs for just our pavement is sitting at around \$450 million, and the word "pavement" is important because it doesn't include the deferred maintenance of things like bridges, sidewalks, and traffic signals. During the course of the next 20 years, the money Sacramento County will get from California due to the recent tax increases will only fix around 1/3 of our current deferred maintenance costs for our pavement issues. This also doesn't account for deferred maintenance costs that are going to stack on top of this for the 2/3 of the roads that don't get worked on between now and then.

This is the most optimistic scenario, because this is making the huge assumption that the State doesn't raid this money and divert it to something else in the future.

As has been proven time and time again, when California is strapped for cash, they have no problem taking the money they need from the Counties and Cities.

If we want our roads to be fixed in anything short of the distant future, we are going to need to either make enormous investments at the local level (to the great expense of other programs), or pass a local tax measure dedicated solely to fixing the problem. But the crafters of such a tax should be careful, as my Orangevale survey I conducted earlier in the year showed that while 51% of you would pass a local transportation tax if it were dedicated solely to the roads, only 14% of you would pass a transportation tax if it included money for other things like public transportation. Either of these two plans poses challenges.



# SUMMER ENERGY SAVING TIPS

This summer's weather conditions seem to be all over the place this year. We've had our waves of sweltering heat and then all of a sudden, without much warning, we've been experiencing cooler and milder days. But regardless of how hot or cool it's been, it's still summer and a lot of people are looking for ways to conserve there energy and reduce their energy bills. Here are just a few tips from the 'Consumer Energy Center - California Energy Commission' that may provide you with some relief:

Be a speedy chef - Nothing is more energy efficient for cooking than your microwave. It uses two-thirds less energy than your stove.

Push a button to wash your dishes - Surprise! Your dishwasher uses less water than washing dishes by hand. Then let dishes air-dry to save even more!

Fill up the fridge - Having lots of food in your fridge keeps it from warming up too fast when the door is open. So your fridge doesn't have to work as hard to stay cool.

Turn up your thermostat - Set your thermostat to 78 degrees when you are home and 85 degrees or off when you are away. Using ceiling or room fans allows you to set the thermostat higher because the air movement will cool the room. Always take into account health considerations and be sure to drink plenty of fluids in warm weather. (Save: 1 - 3 percent per degree, for each degree the thermostat is set above 72 degrees)

Eliminate wasted energy - Turn off appliances, lights and equipment when not in use.

(Save: 2%) Unplug electronic devices and chargers when they aren't in use-most new electronics use electricity even when switched "off." Turn

computers and printers off at the power strip. (Save: 1-2 percent). Unplug or recycle that spare refrigerator in the garage if you don't really need it. This will save you up to \$150 per year! (Save: 10-20 percent).

Replace air conditioner filters - Dirty filters restrict airflow and can cause the system to run longer, increasing energy use. Replace filters monthly for maximum benefit. (Save: 1-2 percent).



# rangevale Cooks

The recipe this week is a great one for a quick meal anytime of the year. This is my motherin-law's Veal Scallopini recipe that I adapted for turkey cutlets. Most measurements are estimates, so feel free to add more of any ingredient and it will turn out just fine.

#### TURKEY SCALLOPINI

1 package turkey breast cutlets

1 cup flour ¼ tsp garlic salt

¼ tsp pepper 12 or more small mushrooms,

sliced thinly Olive oil

Garlic salt

White wine (Recipe originally called for sauterne, but it is not available anymore, so use your favorite white wine such as, Riesling or White Zinfandel)

Flatten turkey to 1/4-in. thickness.

In a pie tin, combine the flour

¼ tsp. garlic salt and pepper. Dip the breast cutlets in the flour. Shake off excess, set aside on a plate.

In a large non-stick frying pan, sauté the mushrooms in olive oil. Sprinkle a dash of garlic salt over mushrooms as they

Remove cooked mushrooms into a bowl and set aside.

Add olive oil to a large skillet. On medium-high heat, cook turkey for 2-3 minutes on each side or until meat is no longer pink and coating is golden brown.

(You can do this in shifts if your pan is not large enough. Just set aside.)

After all meat is cooked, add cooked turkey back to the pan, and then add mushrooms. Heat the mushrooms and turkey.

Add 1/3-1/2 cup wine to the turkey and mushrooms. Heat up the liquid until everything is hot and bubbly.

Serve this over rice and with a nice salad for a great meal!

# SUNNY DAYS, SICK PETS

Warm, dry weather is here to stay for the next few months. In addition to the browning lawns around town, our pets are also feeling the heat. It is important to keep your pets cool and well watered because it's even easier for them to suffer from heat stroke and dehydration. Mild cases can result in lethargy and fever; but severe cases can cause coma or even death!

As humans, we're lucky to be able to sweat (and build air conditioning units!). Our furry family members are not as lucky! There is only so much that panting can do to cool off the body, especially in triple digit heat. If you are feeling hot, just remember your pet is feeling it worse!

The biggest thing to avoid is keeping your pet out of hot cars. The heat inside a car can very quickly rise to oven-like temperatures. Even if your car is in the shade, with the windows cracked, your pet can experience heat stroke in a few minutes. Don't risk the quick run into the market. Just sav no!

Even just being outside can be deadly without adequate water supply and cool shade. You should also consider providing a small wading pool to help them cool off. Dogs that are flat faced (pugs, bulldogs, boston terriers, boxers, etc.) have a narrowed
