Enjoy the early American fiddle, folk and country musical performances in the hall or join the out door jam.





On Tuesday, August 2, my staff and I were happy to join the Sacramento Sheriff's California Department, Highway Patrol, and Metropolitan Sacramento Fire District in celebrating National Night Out. annual event presents an incredible opportunity for local neighborhoods to have direct contact with the public safety personnel who protect our communities every single day.

My staff and I attended over ten events, trying to stop by every neighborhood gathering brought to our attention within the Fourth District. At every one of these events, what we saw was the same: a community that embraces our public safety workers and is thankful for the sacrifices they make on our behalf.

While all of the events my staff and I attended were great, I was surprised that there were fewer registered events this year than in past years. I hope this is not an indication that people are less engaged in their neighborhoods and neighborhood watch groups than in the past. In an era in which the State has released thousands of prisoners onto the streets through AB 109 and Proposition 47, vigilance from the public is needed now more than ever.

If you don't currently have a neighborhood watch, or maybe you do but it has gone inactive, I strongly encourage you to log on to www.sacsheriff.com to find information about creating an active neighborhood watch.

Even beyond the need to be vigilant and proactive in protecting our neighborhoods from changes in State policy that have dramatically undercut the safety of our schools and communities, it is important to engage the Sheriff's Department for a more fundamental reason: our front line law enforcement officers and first responders need to know that you support them.

I know we all say we support law enforcement; few people do not. But it is not enough to talk among your friends and family to express your support for law enforcement. Events like National Night Out are important because they are an opportunity for the community to show their thanks and support in person, to thank our Sheriff's deputies for the work they do, and to show them that we want to take time out from our day to acknowledge their service to our community.

Even writing letters of support means a lot; my staff has told me about the countless notes of appreciation posted on the wall of the briefing room in the Sheriff's North Area Station. Your efforts are noticed, and they are meaningful; please keep them up!





Orangevale Cooks

There is still time for grilling. One of my favorite things to grill is skirt steak. I love to marinade my skirt steak for a few days and then cook on the grill. Skirt steak used to be cheap and easy to find, but now it is a bit pricy for the cut, but it is still worth the taste. This week we have a recipe for skirt steak from Lynne Miles and her daughter Allison. They happened to be watching a video of Alton Brown, a food show presenter, doing a BBQ technique that made their jaws drop.

They tried the recipe and it was wonderful!!

Alton Brown's Steak on Coals

1 1/2 lbs. skirt steak Kosher salt

Place steak on a rack

above a pan and sprinkle liberally with salt. Let sit for 60 minutes at room temperature.

Meanwhile, start enough charcoal to cover bottom of BBQ with a heavy layer.

Evenly distribute coals across bottom of BBQ. Lay meat directly on coals.

Leave on coals for 35-45 seconds. Flip and cook an additional 35-45 seconds. Remove meat to a large piece of heavy duty aluminum foil. Fold into a large airtight pouch. Let sit for 15 minutes.

Stack steak strips and cut into 1/3's. Then rotate pieces and cut against the grain. You can cut on the bias for wider slices.

(Allison said that getting the meat to the plate was the hardest part of this recipe!)

Note: Make sure that you get the strips of skirt steak, not the round ones they sell at a certain grocery store. Also, it can be fatty, so trim a bit of the fat off before cooking. Sometimes, skirt steak is hard to find, but Lynne and Allison have found it at Whole Foods, Raley's, Costco and WinCo.
