THREE BOY SCOUT PROJECTS ENHANCE ORANGEVALE PARKS



Orangevale Recreation and Park District and the Orangevale community have benefited greatly from Boy Scout volunteer efforts to beautify, renovate, or otherwise improve parks and recreation facilities. Recently, three scouts completed Eagle Scout projects in local parks. Zac Hedrick from Boy Scout Troup 355, planned, coordinated, and completed the painting of the Kidz



Korner House including staining the wood fence and walkway around the house. Thirty-nine volunteers contributed 157 hours to complete the project which is the home to the District's pre-school program. Brenton Nash from Boy Scout Troup 537, planned, coordinated, constructed, and installed two Little Free Libraries at Orangevale Community Park and Norma Hamlin Park. Twenty volunteers contributed 154 hours to build and install the Little Free Libraries. Caleb Judd from Boy Scout Troup 121, planned, coordinated, and completed a rock pathway project at Pecan Park around the newly constructed Pecan Dog

Park. Eighteen volunteers contributed over 100 hours to construct the pathway.
