### CASA ROBLE AIR FORCE REINED SUPERIOR









### LETTERS TO THE EDITOR - Regarding Turning Point

Dear Editor

On February 7th, 2017, the Board of Supervisors for Sacramento County approved a development in our Orangevale without giving the community notice to attend the hearing to

make our voices heard. The Board of Supervisors with Orangevale's newly elected Supervisor, Sue Frost trampled our rights as members of the Orangevale community to a fair hearing on development projects in Orangevale.

The project was a proposed Accessory Dwelling on a small lot on Beech Avenue between Elm and Oak Avenue. This project proposed the construction of a second home on an already

impacted parcel of land. Not only would this home be the second one on the property but it soars to over 30 feet in height according to public documents. This means it is more than a mere single family residence; it is a multistory monstrosity in the middle of our Orangevale. This project was presented at the Orangevale Community Planning Council (CPAC) in October. There the CPAC voted to deny the project for obvious reasons. The building is too large and tall,

too dense of development, opposed by neighbors on all sides of it, and inconsistent with our rural Orangevale. Yet the County approved it anyway.

How can the Orangevale community have their voice heard if the County is not notifying us of important meetings? This hearing was not published on the usual County CPAC mailing list nor posted on the CPAC website. How can we make our voices heard if our new Supervisor is approving projects without even telling us; the community, about them? I hope this is a one-time mistake by Supervisor Frost. Our community deserves to

Our community deserves to be heard. Our community deserves to have the opportunity to have our voices heard before our unique Orangevale way of life is threatened any further.

We sincerely thank the hundreds of residents who have joined us to oppose the proposed opening of a Mental Crisis Residential Center on Elm Avenue, just 500 feet from Louis Pasteur Middle School and near three other Orangevale schools.

Our group formed in October after we were shocked to learn that Turning Point Community Programs plans to obtain a zoning change and special permit to open a 15-bed facility in the heart of our semi-rural community.

We are parents, teachers, business owners, retirees, and others united by a single belief – the location for this crisis facility is inappropriate and poses an unnecessary risk to schoolchildren.

We support expanded services for the mentally ill, but Elm Avenue is the wrong location. We also believe the planning process and lack of transparency and communication by Sacramento County and Turning Point show a disregard for our community and quality of life.

The latest updates:

• We have collected signatures from 1,400 residents who oppose the location. Please encourage

relatives and friends to visit our website and sign the petition. www.protectovkids. com

•If you'd like a t-shirt (to wear to the upcoming hearing) or lawn sign, let us know by email (Ericka@protectovkids. com)

•Turning Point's earliest possible hearing date before the Orangevale Community Planning Advisory Council is March 7 at 6:30 p.m. The meeting would be at the Orangevale Community Center and we will need a huge turnout to support our case.

•Turning Point has held at least two meetings with our new county supervisor, Sue Frost, and has offered tours of its existing facilities to elected officials.

•Our group with met Supervisor Frost and while we believe she supports our position, more input from the community is vital. Please call her office to express concerns about the facility. Supervisor Frost is newly elected and will be under tremendous pressure to allow this facility to go through on Elm Avenue. Her office number is 916-874-5491. Dear Editor,

I was very troubled to see a recent letter writer in the Orangevale View mischaracterize residents who oppose the mental crisis center proposed for Elm Avenue. The writer suggested that we are un-Christian and a bunch of heartless "NIMBYs" who have no empathy for people struggling with mental illness. Nothing could be further from the truth. The neighbors I have met through this effort

are all good, hardworking, compassionate people. Each of us supports expanded services for the mentally ill and we all have friends or family touched by this heartbreaking disease. That is not the issue, and it is upsetting that some people have tried to label us unfairly. The real issue is that the facility operator, Turning Point Community Programs, selected a site that is just 500 feet from our local middle school. Louis Pasteur, and within a half-mile of three other Orangevale schools. That creates an immediate safety risk to hundreds of children, a risk that simply would not exist at another site.

The real issue is that the county partnered with Turning Point by providing the operator a grant of more than \$2 million in taxpayer funds, and that neither party bothered to reach out to the community about their plans before the property was purchased. This is a highly offensive oversight, at best, and represents a lack of transparency I find disturbing.

The real issue is that our zoning in this neighborhood – agricultural/residential – was written to give us an assurance that we will continue to enjoy the peaceful lifestyle that makes Orangevale special. If our zoning counts for nothing, and commercial facilities like the proposed mental crisis center are approved on a whim, what's next?

I hope everyone will consider the true facts when evaluating this proposal, and will not be swayed by falsehoods and insults thrown at those with legitimate reasons to oppose it

### BE STORM READY

### **EMERGENCY KIT**

Emergencies happen, and preparation and response can make a world of difference in the impact they have on you and your family. Having the items you need can be a life saver—figuratively and literally—in the event you have to evacuate your home during an emergency. Create an emergency kit and personalize it for your family's particular needs. Check it every six months to be sure it is up-to-date.

Basic Kit

Flashlight and extra batteries

First aid kit and first aid reference material

Radio – wind-up or batteryoperated, with extra batteries Local maps

Water – One gallon per person per day for at least three days

Food – At least a three-day

supply of non-perishable food Whistle, to signal for help Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air

Moist toilettes, garbage bags and plastic ties, for personal sanitation

Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities

Can opener

Contact information for family and friends
ATM and credit cards

Cash and change

Prescriptions (enough for a week), along with a list of medications and dosages for each family member and the reason for use

Eye glasses, hearing aids, and other assistive devices (e.g. cane, walker, etc.)

Portable phone

Personal hygiene items (e.g. toothbrush, toilet paper, etc.) Mylar blanket

Keys

Copies of important documents in a waterproof, portable container (e.g. photo ID, insurance cards and policies, bank account records, etc.)

Plastic sheeting and duct tape, to shelter-in-place

Infant formula and diapers Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person

Household chlorine bleach and medicine dropper. To use as a disinfectant, dilute nine parts water to one part bleach. Or in an emergency, you can use it to treat water by using 16 drops of regular household liquid bleach per gallon of water. Do not use scented, color safe or bleaches with added cleaners.

Matches in a waterproof container

Fire extinguisher

Mess kit, paper cups, plates, plastic utensils, paper towels Pencil and paper

Books and activities for children

Written instructions for how to turn off electricity, gas, and water. Remember, you'll need a professional to turn them back on.







### **KEEP PETS SAFE**

It's important to ensure the safety of all members of the family in disaster, including your pets.

Before an emergency

Make sure your pet has identification, such as an ID tag or microchip.

Locate a shelter for you and your pet. Pets are not allowed in public shelters, so consider alternatives such as homes of family and friends, hotels and motels that allow pets, or kennels and veterinary hospitals.

Have a crate or pet carrier available. This will also prevent your pet from running away in case of panic.

Including the following pet items when preparing your emergency kit:

Extra water

Pet food and medications Copy of your pet's vaccination records

Photo of you with your pet as proof of ownership

Litter, pan or newspaper, and plastic bags for sanitation needs

Leash, collar, and ID tags Pet's favorite toy or familiar items (to reduce stress)

Develop a support team. Ask a neighbor, friend or relative to look after and evacuate your pet if necessary. Tell them where your emergency kit is located and where to meet during the emergency. Prepare a list of emergency contact information including veterinary hospitals and animal control

During an emergency Bring your pets inside during

If you must evacuate without your pet, leave your pet loose inside your home with plenty of food and water. Place a note outside your home with the following information:

Type of pet and where it is in your home

Your contact information


Your vet's contact information

After an Emergency

If you leave town, take your pets with you.

Your pets may be disoriented after the disaster. Give them time to settle down and maintain close contact and monitor them closely.

Changes in your pet's behavior are normal after a disaster, if problems persist contact your veterinarian.




