Church Community (SCC) recently participated in a program called Winter Sanctuary, hosted through Sacramento Steps Forward; a program working to end homelessness in the Sacramento Region. Winter Sanctuary is a rotating homeless shelter and collaborates with various churches around Sacramento to provide shelter and meals during the cold winter months. 28 local churches have opened their doors and hearts by offering a refuge for the homeless, one week at a time. This is the fourth year SCC has participated in Winter Sanctuary and this year was a complete success!! Starting Sunday evening, the homeless are bussed in from Downtown for their stay at Sanctuary at Sunrise. They are greeted and tended to by volunteers. fed a delicious meal, provided entertainment for the evening and even offered PB&J sandwiches with cold milk at bedtime. Each day dozens of our community members volunteered to make this program possible. Some SCC Life-Groups made "blessing bags" for each guest, which included various basic necessities that most of us take for granted. With their hearts full and spirits touched, volunteers selflessly hosted the guests, listened, had great conversations, played games, and one evening some women even provided a pampering / skin care class. One night the SCC Choir performed and uplifted everyone's spirit in the room. A movie played every evening as the guests settled in for the night. Early each morning What an incredible reminder that every person matters, every person has a story, and every person deserves respect and to be treated like a human being. If you want



(4am) volunteers served as the Breakfast Crew who set up the coffee and continental breakfast for the guests to fill their bellies as they packed up and prepared to leave at 6am. They were bussed back to Downtown and returned again each evening for another night of shelter. There were over 100 guests who stayed that week, over 1900 meals prepared, and over 150 Volunteers.

FINAL WALK THROUGH INSPECTIONS

The final 'walk through' is the last opportunity a buyer will have before closing their home purchase. It is always important to do the walk through so that you can be sure the repairs you requested during the escrow process have been completed & that the property is in the same condition as when you first saw it. Here are a few key points before you complete your walk through: Schedule the final walk through as close to the 'closing date' as possible. The ideal time would be before

the closing date & after the sellers have moved out, as specified in the contract date. Be sure that the utilities are on & in working order. Test faucets, toilets, electrical lights. fans. outlets. sprinklers etc.... It is also important to check the walls, ceilings & flooring to make sure no damage was created with the sellers move out. Be sure to have your list of 'requested repairs' with you to verify that the repairs were done.

The final walk through is also the time to ask the sellers about instructions on how to operate any equipment that came with the home, such as pool equipment, thermostats or alarm systems. Be sure to get copies of all the receipts for any repairs that were completed from companies.

Buying a home is very exciting time but you want to make sure everything is in working order. Your Realtor will be able to assist you with the walk through and any questions you may have about the process.





Cooks Cooks

It is report card time and I did not have time to check out new recipes, so I am sharing one from 2013. My little sister enjoys cooking and she frequently sends me pictures of the yummy foods that she has made. She had made a beautiful cake out of oranges, so I tried the recipe and it was easy to make, delicious and full of orange flavor. Sally even made hers gluten-free by using Pamela's gluten free flour instead of regular flour.

WHOLE ORANGE CAKE Cooking-oil spray

1 cup butter, softened (2 cubes)

1 1/4 cups granulated sugar 3 large eggs

2 oranges (about 1 lb. total), ends trimmed, then cut into

chunks and seeded
2 1/2 cups flour
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon baking soda
1/2 teaspoon baking powder
1 1/2 cups powdered sugar
2 tablespoons plus 1 tsp.
orange juice

1. Preheat oven to 325°. Coat a 10-cup Bundt pan with cooking-oil spray. In a large bowl with a mixer on medium speed, beat butter and granulated sugar until fluffy. Beat in eggs.

2. Whirl orange chunks in a food processor until mostly smooth but not puréed. Add 1 1/2 cups orange mixture to batter and beat until

blended. Add flour, salt, baking soda, and baking powder to bowl and beat until smooth. Spread batter in prepared pan.

3. Bake until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out with only a few crumbs clinging to it, about 55 minutes. Cool pan on a rack 10 minutes, then invert cake onto rack and let cool completely.

4. Whisk together powdered sugar and orange juice in a small bowl. Drizzle over cooled cake. Let glaze set, then slice cake. Serves 12 Notes: Yes, you are using the WHOLE orange—peel and all! Just cut off the ends, cut into chunks and remove the seeds. I processed my pretty well, so I didn't have big chunks-close to puree.

When I used my fancy Bundt pan, I sprinkled flour in the pan. Just make sure you get the excess flour out of the pan. The cake came out perfectly

XYLITOL: A BITTERSWEET SWEETENER

Xylitol is a low-calorie, natural sugar alcohol that is growing in popularity as a sugar alternative due to its low glycemic index. It is commonly found in chewing gum, baked goods, candy, dental hygiene products (such as toothpaste and mouth wash), and some over-the-counter medicines and supplements. Now it can even be found in some new brands of peanut butter, which could pose a serious risk to dogs that get peanut butter as a treat or to help administer medications. While xylitol is perfectly safe for humans to consume, our furry companions are not so lucky. Xylitol is highly toxic to dogs, a small dose can cause

life threatening hypoglycemia (low blood sugar) in as little as 30 minutes, but it may also be delayed up to 12 hours after ingestion. Additionally at higher doses xylitol can cause severe liver failure which can occur 12-48 hours later. Symptoms of xylitol toxicity include weakness, lethargy, disorientation, collapse, vomiting, tremors, seizures, black-tarry stool, jaundice, coma, or even death.

The best way to prevent xylitol exposure in our pets is to avoid having any products that contain it in the home. If you must have certain products, then they should be kept safe and secure, well out of the reach of pets. If you suspect you pet has ingested a substance containing xylitol it is best to seek help immediately by calling your

veterinarian or animal poison control. Early detection and treatment of xylitol ingestion is essential, and if we act fast enough, chances of a full recovery are excellent.

So remember when giving any food to our pets, always check the label for xylitol in the ingredient list, especially when something is labelled as "sugarfree" or "no added sugar." Additionally, before giving any over-the-counter medications or supplements, be sure to check the inactive ingredient list for xylitol. When in doubt, don't give it or check with your veterinarian before giving anything new to your pets.







She is happy to achieve the magic number and credits her wonderful family and the OVWC for their love and support. She is quick to note, however, that she still misses playing golf and tennis.
