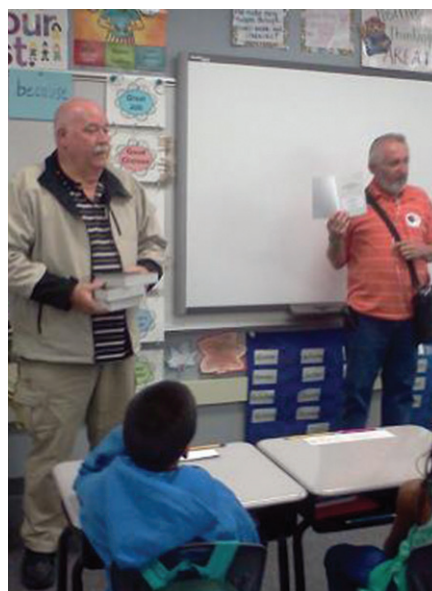
WHAT IS THE ORANGEVALE GRANGE, ANY WAY?

WHAT IS THE ORANGEVALE GRANGE, ANY WAY?

It's been here forever – well since 1910. Its history has been woven into the fabric we call Orangevale ever since. And yet, whatever it is that Grange is about seems to be one of the best kept secrets around. Many folks who have lived here for years have only a vague idea of what the Grange does or what it could mean to them and their families. Let's change that! The members of the Orangevale Grange want you to know about this great organization and want

to welcome you to be a part of the Orangevale Grange Family.

WHY WAS THE GRANGE STARTED?

The Grange is the nation's oldest national agricultural organization, with grassroots in more than 30

States. The National Grange was founded in 1867 as a farm fraternity to meet the needs of farmers everywhere in a country torn apart by a civil war. Once the National Grange was established (in Minnesota) it caught on quickly and began influencing farming and everything related. One example of the Grange's national influence was the passage of the Interstate Commerce Act of 1887. This act protected people by requiring fair railroad rates. The Grange began Rural Free Postal Delivery, Anti-Trust and monopoly laws were lead by the Grange and a Grange member was the first Secretary of Agriculture. Did you know that women in the Grange have always had an equal voting right as men even before the 19th Amendment granted women the right to vote? The Grange has evolved to include non-farm families and communities.

DID YOU KNOW THIS ABOUT THE ORANGEVALE GRANGE?

The first library in Orangevale was in the home of a Grange Member who

served as the town librarian for 45 years. The Grange was instrumental in bringing electricity and telephone service to Orangevale. Both the Folsom and Shasta Dam Projects and the Central Valley Water Project were heavily influenced by our Orangevale Grange. The Grange was the first to donate money toward the purchase of land on Hazel Avenue that would become the Youth Center, which is still being used today. The Grange donated money towards the beautification projects of Casa Robles High School and Louis Pasteur Middle School. Oh let's not overlook the return of the Farmers Market which was cosponsored by the Grange and one of the best known businesses of Orangevale, The Dairy Queen.

OK ENOUGH HISTORY – WHAT DOES THE GRANGE DO TODAY?

While our roots are still in agriculture, the Orangevale Grange has branched out to serve in other ways. If you like to cook, the Grange is for you. We serve breakfast every 2nd

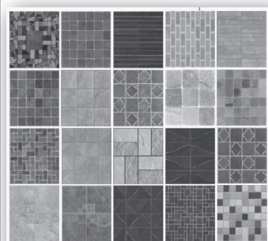



NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE
ORANGEVALE LANDSCAPING
AND LIGHTING ASSESSMENT
DISTRICT (OLLAD)**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Orangevale Recreation and Park District, County of Sacramento, State of California, has previously ordered through Resolution 92-06-51 the formation of an assessment district pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 for the purpose of financing certain park and recreation improvements and refurbishments as specified in the District's updated Master Plan and for the purpose of funding maintenance operations of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board, through Resolution 92-06-51, has ordered that the park and recreation improvements specified in the Engineer's Report dated March 26, 1992, be constructed, and has estimated that the cost of such proposed park and recreation improvements is greater than can be raised from a single annual assessment, and has ordered that the estimated costs of these improvements be raised by an assessment levied and collected in annual installments over a period of 20 years, commencing in fiscal year 1992-93 and ending in fiscal year 2012-13 and then continued from year to year as necessary to fund other capital, maintenance and other needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Orangevale Recreation and Park District, County of

Sacramento, State of California, that:

- On July 17, 1991, by its Resolution No. 816, this Board ordered the formation of and levied the first assessment within the Orangevale Recreation and Park District Maintenance Assessment District 1991 (the "Assessment District") pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972.
- On March 9, 2019 this Board adopted Resolution No. 17-03-566, A Resolution Directing Preparation of the 2017-18 Annual Report for the Orangevale Recreation and Park District Maintenance Assessment District. Pursuant to this resolution, SCI Consulting Group, the Engineer of Work, prepared a report in accordance with Article XIID of the California Constitution and Section 22565, et seq., of the California Streets and Highways Code (the "Report"). The Report has been made, filed with the Clerk of the Board and duly considered by the Board and is hereby deemed sufficient and preliminarily approved. The Report shall stand as the Engineer's Report for all subsequent proceedings under and pursuant to the foregoing resolution.
- It is the intention of this Board to levy and collect assessments within the Assessment District for fiscal year 2017-18. Within the Assessment District, the existing and proposed improvements, and any substantial changes proposed to be made to the existing improvements, are generally described as installation, maintenance and servicing of public recreational facilities and improvements, including, but not limited to, turf and play areas, landscaping, ground cover, shrubs and trees, irrigation systems, drainage systems, lighting, fencing, entry monuments, basketball courts, tennis courts, gymnasium, running tracks, swimming pools, other recreational facilities, security patrols to protect the Improvements, graffiti removal and repainting, and labor, materials, supplies, utilities and equipment, as applicable, at each of the locations owned, operated or

maintained by the Orangevale Recreation and Park District.

- The Assessment District consists of the lots and parcels shown on the boundary map of the Assessment District on file with the Clerk of the Board of the Orangevale Recreation and Park District, and reference is hereby made to such map for further particulars.
- Reference is hereby made to the Engineer's Report for a full and detailed description of the improvements, the boundaries of the Assessment District and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the Assessment District. The Engineer's Report identifies all parcels which will have a special benefit conferred upon them and upon which an assessment will be imposed.
- The assessments are not proposed to increase from the previous year's assessments. The Board of Directors declares its intent to levy and collect assessments for the fiscal year 2017-18 within said district at an assessment rate of \$3.50 per month or \$42.00 per year per single family residential parcel, apartment unit and/or condominium; a lower rate of \$3.08 per month or \$36.96 per year per each mobile home unit or per one-quarter acre parcel devoted to commercial use; and a rate of \$1.40 per month or \$16.80 per year per one-quarter acre for parcels devoted to industrial or mini storage use, all as set forth in the benefit chart included in the Engineer's Report.

CREAM CHEESE CUPCAKES

Cake:
 3- 8 oz. packages of cream cheese, softened
 5 eggs
 1 ½ tsp vanilla
 1 cup sugar

Filling:

1 ¼ cup sour cream
 2 tsp vanilla
 ¼ cup sugar
 24- 2 inch foil cupcake tins
 Maraschino cherries - cut in half

Cake:

In a mixer, beat cream cheese with eggs, adding eggs one at a time. Add sugar and vanilla and beat until smooth. Place cupcake tins on a cookies sheet and fill 2/3 full. Bake at 300 degrees for 40 minutes. The cupcakes will look white, not browned. Let cool for 5 minutes.

Filling:

While the cupcakes are cooking, mix together the ingredients. Set aside.

After the cupcakes have cooled, they will form indentations. Using a spoon, fill the indentations with filling. Put a cherry half on the top. Bake 5 more minutes. Chill.

Store cupcakes in the refrigerator.

The cupcakes freeze well for those who like to plan ahead or who like to have dessert on hand!

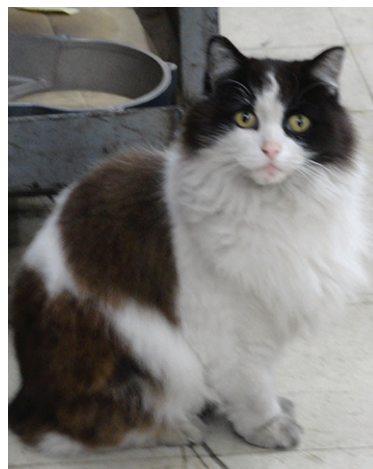

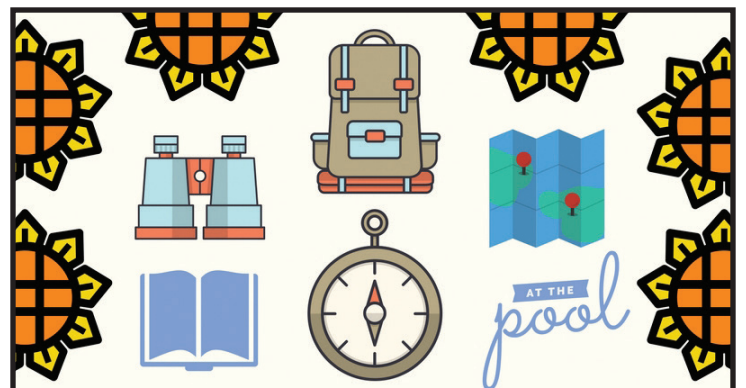

MEMORIAL DAY TRIBUTE

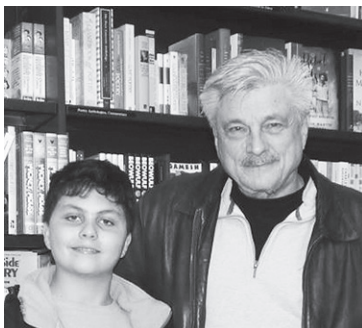

For Memorial Day, Lance Pyle (Peter Blueberry) has written a poem titled, The Sacrifice, to honor and remember those who have died defending the United States in war, as well as today's veterans and active military.

Lance is a local Citrus Heights veteran and poet. His pen name is Peter Blueberry and he reads his poetry to the delight of children and adults.

He visits schools in the Sacramento region and recites from the poetry books he's written titled, It's O.K. To Laugh While you Cry and Inside the Mind of a Blueberry, as well as many others.

His poems are funny and oftentimes teach children how to cope with growing up. He's read his humorous poem titled, Road Warrior at the bedside of veterans at Mather Veterans Hospital, brightening up their day with laughter.

Lance is a Viet Nam Era veteran, Specialist 5th Class, Army, 1968-71. After serving his country, he became an architect, but has since retired because of several bouts of cancer which nearly took his life. After years of depression, one day he recited a silly little poem to his grandson who commented that he should write poetry. That miracle day changed his life. He's been writing and illustrating his own unique brand of poetry ever since.

His poem, The Sacrifice, hangs in the office of the United States Under Secretary of the Army.

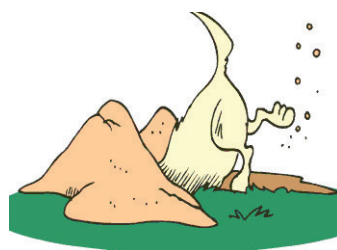

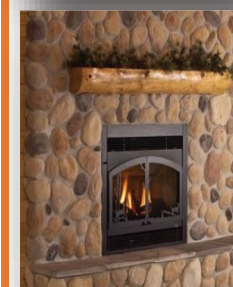
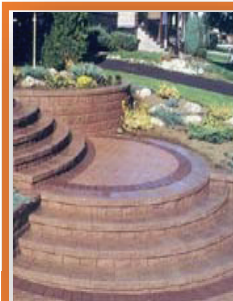
