# **COUNTY SUPERVISOR**

Do we really need another transportation tax?

By County Supervisor Sue Frost Soon after I got sworn into office, I issued a survey to our community to help me evaluate and improve our services based on what you want to see. The survey is now closed, and with over 2,500 total responses, conclusions based on the data can now be made.

To me, the most important question on the survey was the question relating to budget priorities. In every community within my district the number two priority is transportation/ roads (with only public safety ranking higher). It's clear that our entire community feels our roadways are in critical condition and that we can't go much longer adding more to the deferred maintenance of the roads, which is currently at \$450 million and counting.

This is a problem plaguing our entire state, with California's deferred maintenance transportation sitting at \$57 billion. Unfortunately, many California legislators believe the best way to solve this problem is by raising taxes (again). There are two identical bills (AB 1 and SB 1) working their way through the legislative process that appear to be gaining steam and will hit taxpayers in three different ways. They would raise the gas tax by another 12 cents per gallon, they would hike the vehicle license fee by over 50%, and they would raise the cost of registering a vehicle by over 80%.

I urge our state legislators to reject these two proposals, and to find a solution without raising taxes and fees.

California has mismanaged its resources through waste, poured billions of dollars into an unnecessary high-speed rail system that does not even come close to addressing the state's transportation problems,

and devoted a greater and greater share of transportation funds to public transit (which accounts for only a small fraction of the total number of trips taken and has seen declining ridership). Bailing out such mismanagement with tax increases will only enable more of the same dysfunctional behavior. Until the state gets serious about putting its own house in order and making transportation a real priority, policymakers should put the brakes on any tax increases.

Further. lower-income taxpavers are disproportionately burdened by transportation

taxes, since these households spend proportionally more of their income on things like gasoline and registration fees. For example, people making \$24,000 a year spend more than twice as much of their income on gasoline as those earning five times as much. We should be doing what we can to assist families that are struggling, not further burden them.

Finally, I want to thank everyone who attended my Orangevale Community Cabinet meeting on April 7th - it was very helpful for me to discuss issues directly with the community. My next one will be on June 2nd at 7:30am at Annie's Breakfast on Greenback and Beech. 



The teams installed smoke detectors with 10 vear batteries in bedrooms hallways, changed improperly sited carbon monoxide detectors. assessed home exits, and provided




packets with fire prevention and fire safety tips.

The Red Cross is working through the nationwide Home Fire Campaign, to reduce deaths and injury from homes fires by 25% by 2020. A two minute evacuation plan should be in place in all homes to escape fire and lethal smoke inhalation: all bedrooms must now dead batteries, relocated have a smoke detector per state law and the detectors should be tested monthly to assure that information they are working properly. Emphasis is placed on awareness and education about the dangers of home fires. The smoke detectors were provided to the Gold Country Red Cross by a PG&E grant.

# UNSEEN CAUSES OF ITCHING AND BITING

Gear up, everyone; flea season is upon us! Flea allergies can be tricky because, with the advent of good flea medications, we don't always find the jumping/crawling culprits of severe itching on our pets. Even if you don't actually see fleas, all it takes is one or two to jump on, bite, and jump off to set off the skin allergies that make your pet miserable. When you do see a flea, you are catching only 5% of the flea population. The remainder includes eggs, pupae, larvae and the adult fleas you aren't finding. We are seeing more and more pets that have never had a flea issue before suffer from these bothersome bugs.

Flea allergy dermatitis (FAD) is characterized by

itching, hair loss and red bumps around the lower back, base of the tail, or back of the thighs in dogs. In cats, we can find these red bumps almost anywhere. The allergy caused by fleas can be intense and is usually not controlled with simple over- the-counter antihistamines. Once the allergies are in full force, your veterinarian can help you get the right medication to get your furry companion comfortable once again.

The best strategy against fleas is good prevention. Although shampoos are helpful for any fleas on your pet at that time, they do little to provide lasting protection. There are topical drops that work well for dogs and cats and even an oral pills that last 1-3 months for dogs. Just make sure to buy a brand

your veterinarian approves as many OTC products are simply not effective. You should also reapply the topical product (except ones containing heartworm medication) after using a shampoo, as this will wash off most of the product, regardless of what the label says. Following these simple steps will help treat, or better yet prevent, these little creatures from putting a cramp in your summer plans!



# JOURNEY TO HONOR THE BRAVE WORLD WAR II AMERICAN AND FILIPINO PRISONERS OF WAR

On Saturday March 18, 2017, ten cadets from the Casa Roble High School Air Force Junior ROTC and their Senior Aerospace Science Instructor, Lt Col Kevin Houdek, embarked on a journey to honor the brave World War II American and Filipino prisoners of war that endured the infamous Bataan Death March.

This event hosted for the past two years by Hiram Johnson High School, was created to recognize the victims of a horrific death march in 1942 in which 60-80 thousand prisoners of war were forced to march over 65 miles. Thousands perished along the march from the oppressive heat and the harsh treatment of their Japanese captors. In remembrance of this event, cadets from JROTCs all around the northern California area gather together for a minimum 14 mile march to honor those men and women that endured that event.

This year, Casa Roble AFJROTC accepted the challenge and gathered a team to compete. Starting in January, the students prepared for the march, walking distances of 3, 5, and 7 miles on the trails. Then, on March 18, the unit took ten team members to Lake Natoma to take part in the march. The cadets marched a distance of over 16.2 miles over the day, walking over 38,000 steps in a time of 7 hours, 13 minutes, and 10 seconds. The cadets

endured the long trail with the help of their brothers and sisters from neighboring ROTC units, encouraging each other along the way. Over the day, the cadets circled the circumference of the lake, not returning until the late afternoon. Casa Roble cadets were tired, and a little sore but reenergized being the first school to get across the finish line. Every cadet in the end were proud of their achievement and each were thrilled to have honored the veterans of the Bataan March. The Casa Roble team was proud to have participated, and are all looking forward to attend again next year.


