We hope once again you can come out with a camera crew and get this on the late news. This


is important for the people of Sacramento to see that something like this can really happen and hope spark interest. Respectfully,





Dear Editor:

I was glad to read in the Orangvale View about the change to the voting procedures to send absentee ballots to all county voters. This will increase percentage of people who vote. Oregon has used mail voting for more than 15 years and has a much higher voter turnout than California. I wasn't surprised to see our Republican Supervisor Sue Frost opposed this (while all the other supervisors, who are all Democrats, supported it) as this is a very partisan issue with Republicans almost always doing all they can to decrease the number of people who are easily able to vote. If more people vote it almost always favors the Democrats. The Republicans frequently argue the reason they favor policies which make it more difficult for people to vote is a fear of voter fraud even though there is no evidence that this is a widespread problem. For example in Oregon there have been more than 15 million votes cast by mail with only nine known incidents of voter fraud. Sincerely, David Moore, Orangevale, CA

SENATOR GAINES' **TAXPAYER** PROTECTION BILL PASSES ASSEMBLY **COMMITTEE** 

SACRAMENTO - Senator Ted Gaines (R-El Dorado) today announced his Senate Bill 11, a measure that would proactively waive penalties and interest for taxpayers when a California Board of Equalization (BOE) system failure prevents them from making tax payments on time, passed unanimously out of the Assembly Committee on Revenue and Taxation.

"California taxpayers shouldn't be on the hook for penalties and interest because of a state website outage," said Senator Gaines. "Senate Bill 11 is simple and fair, two elements of good governance that are too often missing in California. I look forward to continued support for this important taxpayer protection bill as it makes its way through the Assembly."

Under existing law, tax payments made after the filing deadline are subject to interest and penalty. The BOE is currently authorized to waive any penalties or interest if the late payment is due to a disaster or BOE error, however, it is the responsibility of the taxpayer to file paperwork and petition for a refund.

Senate Bill 11 comes on the heels of four separate BOE computer system failures over the past year, two of which occurred during peak filing deadlines leaving taxpayers unable to pay their tax bills on time.

Senator Ted Gaines represents the 1st Senate District, which includes all or parts of Alpine, El Dorado, Lassen, Modoc, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, Shasta, Sierra and Siskiyou counties.



# SUMMER SAFETY TIPS DON'T BE A VICTIM OF SUMMERTIME CRIME

As summertime reaches its peak so does household property crime. The National Crime Prevention Council (NCPC), and McGruff the Crime Dog® are here to provide you and your loved ones with important safety tips to make your summer safe and enjoyable.

"Summer is the perfect time for a family break, but criminals don't take a summer break," said NCPC's CEO, Ann M. Harkins. "You can avoid becoming a victim to lurking property predators by staying alert and following a few basic prevention measures."

According to the Bureau of Justice Statistics, – "Household property crimes exhibited a pattern of seasonal fluctuations from 1993 to 2010. The most common pattern for household property crimes was that victimization occurred at higher rates during the summer than during other seasons."

Be aware of what's happening in the neighborhood: Download the McGruff Mobile app (available on iTunes or Google Play) to stay up-to-date regarding home and vehicle burglaries near your home. Receive and share information on the virtual neighborhood watch about suspicious activity in your neighborhood and receive alerts when you are away.

Lock your doors, including the garage door. Unlocked doors are open invitations to intruders.

Ask a trusted family member, friend, or neighbor to keep a watchful eye on your home or have your mail held at the local post office until your return.

Put lights on timers to give the impression that someone is home.Don't post on social media that you are leaving town, and wait post photos after you return from your trip.

#### **Vacation Tips**

Lock your room and remember not to give out your room number or invite strangers into your hotel room.

Be friendly but be vigilant. Watch for and report any suspicious behavior.

Plan your route – stay within well-traveled routes and walk in groups. There's safety in numbers.

Keep your belongings secure Purses should be securely closed, backpacks are zipped, and wallets are kept in your front pocket. When dining in restaurants do not hang your purse or backpack on the back of your chair.

#### Tips for Parents

Be proactive – make a backup plan in case the group gets separated during a family outing and have a scheduled meeting place and time.

If your child or teen will be alone a significant amount of time, have him/her check in with you if they plan to leave the house and when they arrive back home.

Monitor Internet and social media activity to establish children and teens are visiting appropriate sites and following guidelines.

#### **Car Safety Tips**

Always lock your doors and roll up your windows when you leave your car.

Do not leave valuables in the car. If you must leave prized possessions in your vehicle keep them out of sight or hidden in the trunk.

Before you get into your car, check the backseat and around the car. Lock your doors once inside the car.





#### **ZUCCHINI SOUP**

3 lbs. zucchini, with skin 4 strips of bacon, uncooked 1-3 cloves garlic

1 TBSP basil, dry or fresh 3-4 sprigs of fresh parslev or 1 TBSP dry

24 oz. chick, beef, or vegetable broth

Salt and pepper, to taste

Cube or chunk zucchini, bacon and garlic and place into a large pot. Add basil, parsley, seasoning broth and then simmer for 30 minutes. Pour batches of cooked mixture into a blender and purée to chunky or smooth, depending on your preference.

Serve plain or with and parmesan cheese croutons.
