





ROTARY FIGHTS SEX TRAFFICKING

"It doesn't happen here." This is the most common response when someone mentions sex trafficking in our area. But the Sacramento region is considered to be a hotbed for sex trafficking in the United States with California recording the highest volume of what many call "modern day slavery." With the recent approval of a significant, groundbreaking grant from The Rotary Foundation, Rotary is stepping up to work with local agencies and governments to combat this problem through prevention efforts.

The funding for this project from The Rotary Foundation is unique in that Foundation funding usually goes to projects in developing countries in the Rotary's mission is to tackle some of the world's biggest challenges, locally and globally, through the collective leadership and expertise of its 1.2 million members. With the awareness of sex trafficking in our area, local Rotarians stepped up to lead and organize education and public awareness efforts and bring Rotary Foundation funding to our community.

District Attorney Anne Marie Schubert welcomes Rotary's partnership in the effort to prevent sex trafficking in the Sacramento region. "This Rotary partnership is a testament to how strong community collaborations can make a significant impact in preventing victims of human trafficking and other crimes" said Schubert.

Rotary District 5180, consisting of 41 Rotary clubs

in the greater Sacramento area. Walnut Grove. Yuba City/Marysville. Gridlev and Oroville, will fund both an education and a public awareness campaign with approximately \$340,000 in combined grant and local funding. The vision is to create a sustainable large-scale project in the Sacramento region to fight human trafficking and then replicate the project globally through Rotary's over 1.2 million membership network of 35,000 clubs worldwide.

The education portion involves training school administrators. educators and students in the 5th. 7th, 9th and 11th grades on human trafficking. Rotary District 5180 will partner with 3Strands Global (ht tp://3strandsglobalfounda tion.org/) to provide their PROTECT program (Prevention Organization To Educate Children on Trafficking), which has the approval and support of the Office of the California Attorney General and the Department of Education. The delivery of this program raises awareness and helps both teachers and students understand and recognize human trafficking to create a generation less susceptible to victimization. It is important to relay the message to teens and young adults about how to prevent becoming a victim of human trafficking as well as instilling values that discourage sex consumerism. The public awareness portion will be accomplished through a partnership with The Voices and Faces Project (http://www.voicesandfaces. org/) through their Ugly Truth campaign. According to Anne K. Ream, founder

of The Voices and Faces Project, the campaign was piloted in Illinois in 2013 where it contributed to legislative reform through the passage of three new state laws regarding human trafficking. It is a proven media model that has been adopted by seven U.S. cities with measurable success.

The goal of the campaign in the greater Sacramento area is to raise the level of public awareness of human trafficking and is aimed at informing the public as well as effecting change in public Until the public policy. understands the truth about the conditions that girls, boys, women, and men live in when being trafficked, this issue will persist and grow. Resources and 800 numbers will also be advertised to give those being trafficked support to reach out for help. "If you're paying for sex, you could be paying for someone's pain" is just one example of a headline from their advertising.

The education segment will begin in early 2018 and will be provided in schools in Sacramento, Sutter, Placer, Yolo, Yuba, Butte and El Dorado counties. It is anticipated that the Ugly Truth campaign will roll out in within the same time frame.

To enhance the efforts of Rotary and increase the impact and breadth of both the education and public awareness pieces, additional funding is still being sought. Corporate and individual donations may be made at http://rotary5180.org/. This link also provides additional details on the initiative.

Over the past few years, drone technology has come a long way. Drones are no longer just for professionals or serious hobbyists. New less expensive amateur drones have become all the rage. If you're looking to purchase a drone for Christmas, it is helpful to know what types of drones are available.

Amateur Drones – priced \$10 to \$200

These drones are great for beginners and while easy to fly they can be just as easy to crash. They are more affordable, but may not offer the GPS and stability functions the hobbyist and professional drones have. Therefore, having eyes on the drone at all times is essential for safe and fun flight.

Hobby and Racing Drones – priced \$200 to \$1000

Some perks to these drones include inflight camera, GPS, and return to home functions. These drones may require extra accessories such as a smart phone or tablet to control the photography and utilize First Person View (FPV). 3D goggles may also be needed for operation of racing drones.

Professional Drones – priced \$1,000 to \$10,000+

These drones are used for many applications including photography, search and rescue, construction inspection and 3D mapping. They are typically linked to three or more GPS satellites and have collision avoidance sensors to ensure safer flight and recovery. If the drone is used professionally, the FAA requires that the pilot obtains a Part 107/UAS or



333 Exempt operator license. While operating your drone, always use common sense, good manners and be respectful of other's privacy. To learn more about drone regulations visit https://www.faa.gov/uas.

Every year my mother-inlaw would make dozens of cinnamon rolls for the family. My sister-in-law took up the duty for several years, but now it is up to each of us to make our own. I am sharing the recipe so that you can start the tradition in your family. One batch is enough for a regular size family. Read through the recipe and plan for the time. It takes a bit of time to complete, but the results are amazingly

Edna's Cinnamon Rolls

2- 9 x 12 or 9 x 13 pansmakes 24 cinnamon rolls total

2 Packages yeast- if using bulk, then 1 pkg=2 ¼ tsp yeast (for a total of 4 ½ tsp veast)

½ cup water (110 degrees) 1 ½ cup milk, lukewarm ½ cup shortening 34 cup granulated sugar 2 tsp salt 2 eggs, well beaten 5-7 cups sifted flour ½ cup flour to work with, if kneading by hand

Make the Dough first. When it has almost doubled in size. then get the pans and filling ready.

Filling: ½ cube softened butter, ½ cup granulated sugar and 2 tsp cinnamonyou will divide butter and sugar mixture in half for each dozen.

In bottom of pans: ½ cube softened butter, ½ cup brown sugar, a few thsp granulated sugar and 2 tsp cinnamon (may need to add more sugar mixture to make sure pans are covered)- this is divided in half for each pan.

Note: If you feel the need to add more butter, then do so sparingly. It doesn't make them better, but you might need more to cover the pan

or spread on the dough.

Dough:

1. Combine yeast with water. In mixer or another bowl, combine milk, shortening, sugar, and salt

2. Add yeast and eggs

3. Stir in 2 cups flour, then add enough flour until easy to handle. Turn out onto lightly floured board or use mixer to knead.

If using mixer, knead until dough sticks to dough hook

- 4. Place in greased (oiled) bowl, turn dough over so all gets oiled
- 5. Cover with a towel and let rise until doubled- about 1 ½ to 2 hours. It is done when impression in dough remains.
- 6. Punch dough down and divide in half
- 7. Roll each half into a rectangle 15 x 9 inches
- 8. Spread softened butter over each rectangle, then sprinkle all over with cinnamon sugar 9. Roll starting with narrow edge, seal end by pinching along length of roll.
- 10. Cut into 12 slices. I usually cut in half and then half each half and so on.
- 11. Spread softened butter in pans and sprinkle with brown sugar mixture -be sure all is covered
- 12. Cover and let rise until doubled- about 30 minutes
- 13. Bake in a 375 degree oven for 25 to 30 minutes.
- 14. Immediately turn over onto foil so that all the sugar and butter that was on the bottom is now at the top. Let cool. Then wrap in foil and freeze or eat. Enjoy!






