We are a group of (4) mom's that would like to share a story of love, courage, faith and personal strength with you from one of our very own families right here Orangevale. We hope that you find the following story inspiring and leaves you desiring to be part of our cheer team for McKenzie her mom Missy and sisters Gabby and Phoebe.

On November 30th, 2017 McKenzie was having abdominal pains, so her mom "Missy" took her to the ER which resulted in emergency surgery. 15 days later Missy received a call from UC Davis Hospital telling her to return McKenzie right away that a bed was waiting for her. It was at this point the Ballentine family learned that McKenzie had Burkitt's Lymphoma and chemo treatment needed to be started ASAP. It was that moment when their family's lives changed. Missy took a leave of absence from work and has been by McKenzie's side from day one. Gabby is running the household as well as working to help with the bills. Phoebe is helping Gabby and is trying to stay focused on her senior year of high school at Casa Roble. Unfortunately, right now they are no longer all under one roof.

Here's a little backstory: McKenzie was raised by her mom Missy, who is a single

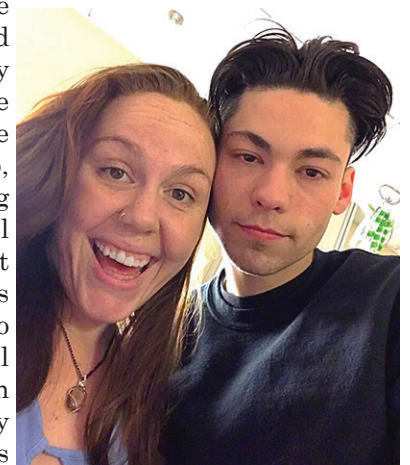


parent of three daughters. Missy was born and raised in Orangevale and was active in sports and cheer as young girl. She has and continues to raise her daughters McKenzie, Gabby and Phoebe in our small town, which they love so fondly. Missy has stayed very active in our community volunteering at Casa Roble High School being an active member of the Booster club, chaperoning dances, being team mom for the High School cheer team or helping get dressing donated for girls (that cant afford one) to go to dances. That is just a small glimpse into Missy's passion of being an active community member. Not only did the girls follow their mom's footsteps for the love of cheering but also for the love of mentoring the youth in our community with the Casa Roble Jr. Rams Cheerleading Program.

In March of 2015, McKenzie

PROPOSES RETURNING \$7.5 BILLION BUDGET SURPLUS DIRECTLY TO TAXPAYERS

SENATOR GAINES INTRODUCES TAXPAYER REFUND BILL

Proposes returning \$7.5 billion budget surplus directly to taxpayers

SACRAMENTO – Senator Ted Gaines (R-El Dorado) today announced legislation that will give the \$7.5 billion budget surplus back to hard-working California families and businesses in the form of a refund check.

“While California taxpayers continue struggling to make ends meet, the Legislative Analyst’s Office reported that the state is

sitting on a budget surplus of an additional, unexpected \$7.5 billion,” said Senator Gaines. “The reason there is a surplus is because Legislative Democrats have continued to overtax Californians and it’s time to send that money right back to taxpayer pocketbooks.”

The legislation will take the state’s \$7.5 billion surplus and return it to the taxpayers. Every Californian who filed taxes for 2016 will get their share of that surplus back in a refund check from the government that could amount to hundred dollars per taxpayer.

“I know the legislature will be tempted to continue the tax-and-spend cycle by sinking every

extra dollar into expanding an ever-growing list of government services and projects, like granting more rights to undocumented immigrants and funding the boondoggle that is High-Speed Rail.

“But we cannot continue to price families and small businesses out of the state, sending them to neighboring states where the tax burden is much lower. We can’t keep fixed-income seniors teetering on the edge of poverty. That’s why I’m carrying a bill to get every single tax filer a refund of the money they overpaid to the government. It’s their money and it’s our obligation to return it.”

5 Signs it Might Be Time to Reduce Your Asking Price

If your house has not sold and it has spent more than the average number of days on the market for your area, then price may be your issue. There are a few indicators that point to price as the reason your home isn't selling.

1. No Showings

One indicator that your price may be too high is that you have no showings in a reasonable amount of time. If you are not seeing the amount of activity you should be, then one conclusion is that the price is too high and deterring buyers from even taking an initial look.

2. Feedback From Showings

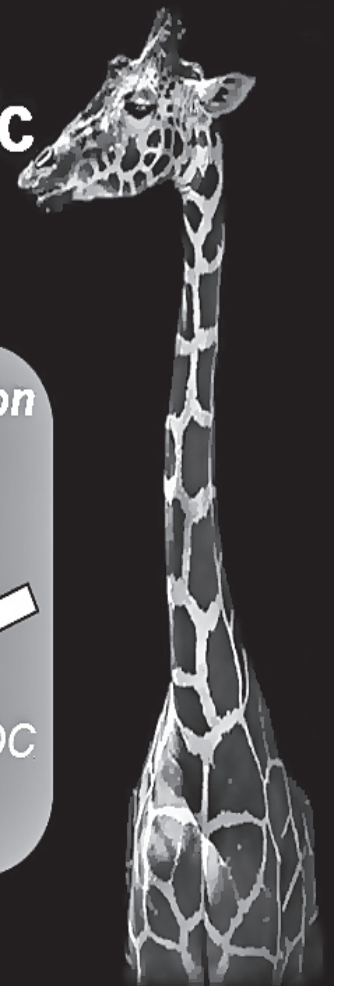

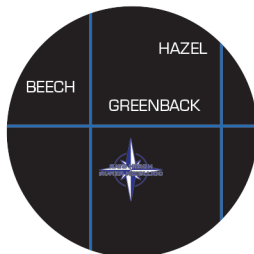

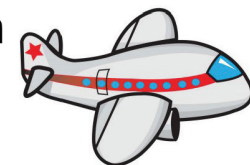

Lemon bars are like chocolate chip cookies when it comes to recipes. Everyone has a favorite recipe for each and most of the recipes contain the same ingredients. It is amazing that when you change the amount of each ingredient, it changes the flavor, texture, or color of the final product. This week I am sharing a recipe for lemon bars that Hailey Buehler brought to the Ottomon Elementary staff party. I have several recipes for lemon bars and these were amazing! Use the Meyer lemon for the best flavor!

LEMON BARS

For the crust:

- 1 1/2 cups all purpose flour
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 1 tbsp lemon zest
- 1/2 cup butter (room temperature)

For the filling:

- 4 large eggs
- 1 1/3 cups sugar
- 1 cup lemon juice, freshly squeezed and strained

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350. Line 9x9 baking pan with **aluminum foil**.

Make the crust. In a large bowl, whisk together flour, sugar, salt and lemon zest. Cut butter into chunks and add to flour mixture. Blend in with an electric mixer at low speed until mixture forms coarse, sandy crumbs. Pour into pan and press mixture down (with your fingers or

the back of a spoon) into an even layer.

Bake for 16-19 minutes, until just lightly browned around the edges.

While crust is baking, make filling. Whisk together all filling ingredients in a large bowl.

When the crust comes out of the oven and is still hot, pour in filling mixture.

Bake for about 20 minutes, or until filling is just set (it will still jiggle when the pan is gently moved). Filling will continue to set as the crust cools.

When bars are completely cooled, refrigerate for at least 1 hour before slicing. Top slices with confectioners' sugar to serve.

Makes about 24 bars. Note from Suzanne: I cooked my filling just a little longer because the filling was not as set as I thought it should be.
