## LADY RAMS HEAD TO PLAYOFFS



Casa Roble High School Girls Varsity Soccer Team 2017-18

The Casa Roble High School women's varsity soccer team has made the playoffs after a five year absence. The Lady Rams last league game on February 8th versus El Camino would determine who would advance to the playoffs. The Lady Rams capitalized with a 3 to 2 victory. After the game, Coach Nolen was full of smiles, "I am so happy for the players and our school. These players have played so hard all year long and had a few games decided by one goal. For us to win this game, knowing what was at stake, was incredible!"

The team consists of 21 players ranging from freshman to seniors coached by 2nd year head coach David Nolen and 1st year assistant coach Joe Tanner. Coach Nolen was previously the assistant coach for 3 years with then head coach Candy Stickney. The Lady Rams started off the preseason with five wins and 2 losses. They play in a very difficult league with Vista Del Lago, Rio Americano, Christian Brothers and El Camino High School. "This is such a brutal league with some extremely amazing coaches. Vista Del Lago was very gracious in letting us use their field, as our home

field while our home field was being completely renovated." Every game the Rams played this season was an away game. "It's not often you hear of a team making it to playoffs, never having any home field advantage", coach Nolen added.

Hannah Hennelly is a 2nd year varsity player who unfortunately

missed the entire season due to an ACL injury.

The Lady Rams did not wait until the first week of conditioning to get ready for the season. Coach Nolen opened the weight room 3 days a week, beginning in June. "Weight training was awesome. When the players first started they could barely squat a bar. As the weeks went on, they started adding weight and were getting stronger. You could see the confidence building."

Casa Roble varsity women's soccer will know who they play in the first round of the playoffs on Friday February 16th and their first game will be on February 21st. "Even though we are very excited to be here the players want to win."

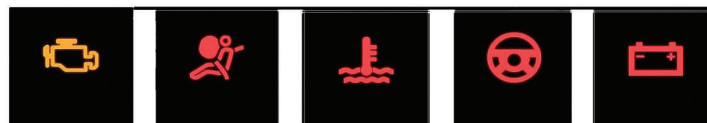

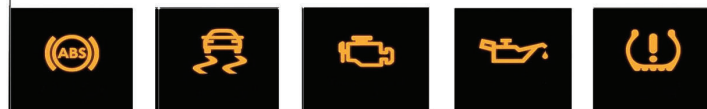

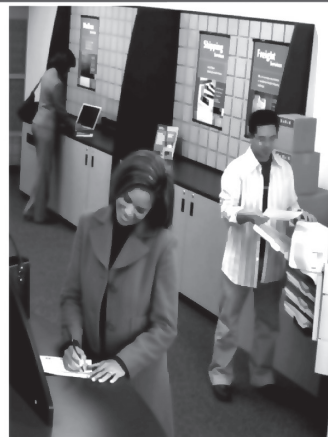

## THE VALUE OF FAILURE

Although I am an active junior at GBHS, I enrolled in a speech contest with cash-based prizes. I poured my heart into the speech. I wrote and rewrote it. I asked for proofreading from my teachers. I practiced until an hour before the contest. But I didn't win. Other kids, with more experience, did. Already feeling sick over the hours of prep wasted in lieu of sleep, I became even more depressed as each contestant was required to rehearse their achievements and goals. Some spoke of the clubs they had founded. Others spoke of their awards in writing/speech and extraordinary achievements in student government. All spoke of their dream Ivy League Universities. When my turn came, I realized I had nothing to present. I left with feelings of worthlessness that persisted in the following weeks. However, a realization gradually dawned on me. What was stopping me from running a club, joining student government, or simply becoming successful? Nothing but hard work. In replacing my mindset, I applied for two summer internships-one for Kaiser Permanente and one for Bank Of America. I replaced my easier classes in my schedule with more worthwhile pursuits. I started the paperwork for a school club, providing funding for wells in underdeveloped countries. In the process, I learned about the power of failure. Everyone experiences

setbacks as a part of life, whether it is the loss of a job, death of a loved one, abuse or failure after commitment. But how we choose to deal with these hardships is the defining trait between personal growth or personal embitterment. We need to accept challenges as opportunities, and recognize that despite painful experiences and hardships, we can still choose to learn from them and ultimately become better.

## WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH -MARCH 2018

### A FINAL TRIBUTE HONORING A SPECIAL LADY DURING WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH March 2018

Women's History Month celebrates the vital role of women in American history. The vibrancy and legacy of women past and present unifies and nourishes our collective whole as we march onward towards fundamental human equality.

Lieutenant Lynn Balmer, born September 12, 1907, on the family homestead in Plumas, California, saw history unfold before her eyes and created a bit of history herself. On her 108th birthday, she was recognized by American Legion Post 709, Rancho Cordova, California, as the oldest living female member of the American Legion.

However, now this special lady has been called to Post Everlasting. Lynn Balmer died peacefully at her home at Country Village in Chico, California, on December 9, 2017, at the vintage age of 110.

She was a lifetime member of American Legion Post 709, Rancho Cordova, California, where her nephew, Sgt. Ken Hicks, U.S. Air force veteran, was Historian. He is currently an active member of Post 709.

She was also a lifetime member of the American Legion Auxiliary Unit 637, Citrus Heights, California. After WWII started, Lynn Balmer joined the military, "to free a man for active duty." She served

in the U.S. Coast Guard and achieved the rank of Lieutenant (junior grade) LTJG. Lt. Balmer secured a top secret clearance and worked in Military Intelligence. Using her keen mathematical abilities, she read and interpreted weather maps and charts and used morse code to help ships navigate through dangerous waters and adverse weather conditions between the United States and England. Prior to her military service, Lt. Balmer was an elementary school teacher, teaching her first class in 1927. She later taught mathematics to high school students. In 1943, her passion for teaching and love for her students, (having no children, she treated each and every child as her own) gave way to her patriotism and love of country when she enlisted in the U. S. Coast Guard.

Yes, Lt. Balmer entered two noble professions and gave of her immense talents whole heartedly.

Between the years of 1946 and 1967 she attended the University of Washington part time, taught mathematics to junior high school students, volunteered at a children's orthopedic hospital, and was a professional skater to boot! She retired and moved to Chico, California, in the late 1990s with her husband, Charles.

Lynn Balmer's passion for life lives on. She told stories about living through World War 1, living through the nationwide flu epidemic in 1918 by wearing bags of asafetida around her neck to school, living through the Great Depression, and when there were shortages of grain

and sugar, feeling very lucky that her father had bees so their family of nine children had honey.

Her nephew, Sgt. Hicks, and her extended family and friends continue to carry on Lt. Balmer's storytelling to the delight of young and old alike. The Women's Suffrage movement was going strong in her childhood and when Lynn was 18 years old, she recalled that her mother got to vote for the first time in her life during the 1920 election. When Lynn became of legal age, she, too, proudly exercised her right to vote and encouraged all women, young and old, to exercise their hard-earned right to vote.

Lt. Balmer's deep love of country and patriotism still flourishes in the lives she touched personally and by the sheer power of her being.

Lt. Balmer died at 110 years old leaving a personal legacy of a life well lived. She did not let life pass her by. Her deep love of country and patriotism ignited her commitment to help protect our democracy and way of life.

She had richness of character, strength, gentleness, and a pioneer spirit exemplifying qualities of our American Legion veterans.

During Women's History Month, it is only fitting we pay special tribute to Lt. Balmer and reflect upon and celebrate the lives of famous women pioneers and leaders in our history, as well as celebrate the unsung women heroes of our daily lives.

## 3 Common Mistakes When Refinancing Your Home

Ready to refinance your home loan to one with a lower interest rate? Or maybe you want to refinance to either a shorter- or longer-term loan. Most times, this refinance will move along smoothly. However, there are times when homeowners make critical mistakes that either slow or scuttle the refinance process. Here are three wrong turns to avoid if you want your refinance to be as easy and stress-free as possible.

1. Don't Skimp on the Paperwork  
Before lenders can approve your request for a refinance, they'll need to see some key

paperwork: copies of your two most recent paycheck stubs, tax returns, and W-2 forms along with bank account statements from the last two years.

2. Don't Forget to Do the Math

Refinancing isn't free. In general, you can expect to pay from 1 percent to 1.5 percent of your loan amount in closing costs. For a mortgage loan of \$200,000 that comes out to \$2,000 to \$3,000. You need to make sure then, before even applying for a refinance, that your 'drop in' interest rate or the drop in monthly payment (when changing loan terms) leaves enough savings to make this move a smart one.

3. Don't Forget Your Credit Scores

You might not qualify for a refinance if your three-digit FICO score has fallen since you first took out your

original mortgage. If your score is too low, you might not qualify for an interest rate that is low enough to make refinancing financially worthwhile.

So before even starting the refi process, check your credit scores from the three national credit bureaus, Equifax, Experian and TransUnion. If your credit cards or banks don't provide these scores, you can order them from the bureaus—usually around \$15 for each score—but at least you'll know beforehand whether a refinance is an option.

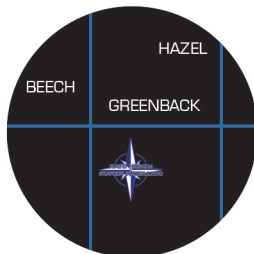

# Orangevale Cooks

On Valentine's Day, at about 5:30 pm, I had a craving for shrimp scampi. My brother-in-law has an amazingly easy recipe for shrimp scampi, so I whipped it up in a few minutes and we were eating by 6:30

- to ½ cup
- ¾ tsp. basil
- ½ tsp. oregano
- 3 large garlic cloves
- ½ tsp. salt
- Pinch of white pepper
- 1 Tbsp. lemon juice

Lay prawns in a 9x11 (ish) sized baking dish. Add the ½ cup reduced wine to the butter mixture and then pour over prawns. Broil in oven (middle rack) until pink/orange color, then turn prawns over to the other side and broil until pink/orange color, approximately 8-12 minutes total. Serve with French bread. Make 3 servings.

Note: Suzanne used peeled and deveined tail on shrimp (21-30 per pound) and regular pepper because the white pepper was unavailable in the cupboard! Enjoy!
