Note game time correction: JV starts at 5 pm, and Varsity kicks off at 7 pm, not 7:30 pm for all home games.

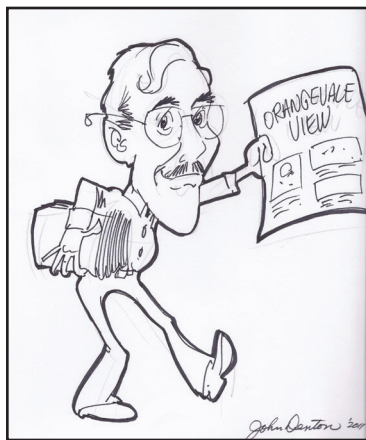

TIME TO FIX DMV

Time to Fix the DMV

At the Department of Motor Vehicles, state employees are sleeping on the job. Literally.

A recent report revealed that one particular employee had a habit of sleeping several hours each day while on the clock. This went on for years without discipline, amounting to \$40,000 in taxpayer-funded naptime.

This story offers a particularly vivid illustration of the growing dysfunction of California's DMV. In the last year alone, wait times have increased by 60% in the Sacramento Valley and 48% in the Bay Area. California residents are furious, and justifiably suspect that it is not just a single employee, but much of the DMV bureaucracy, that has been asleep at the wheel.

The proximate cause of the crisis is the new federal mandate for REAL ID. Since applications have to be processed in person, DMV offices have seen a surge in foot traffic as they work to service 23 million Californians by 2020. Area residents tell me stories of having to wait months to schedule an appointment – and up to an additional eight hours while in line at the DMV itself.

The truth is, these problems could have been avoided. The DMV has had more than a decade to prepare for the advent of REAL ID, and the agency's budget has already

been supplemented by \$70 million. Fast forward to this summer, however, and the DMV has still not met its hiring goals. Furthermore, it has only recently begun offering limited weekend office hours, far short of its promise earlier in the year to expand 8:00-to-5:00 services to every Saturday and extend weekday hours to 7:00 p.m.

Such obvious examples of mismanagement suggest that it would be woefully irresponsible, as recently proposed by the chairman of the Budget Committee, simply to “throw more money at the problem.” The Legislature must take seriously its responsibility for oversight, which means determining whether the DMV has a long-term plan for reducing wait times; investigating how the DMV has spent the \$23 million provided so far to speed up services; and establishing how the DMV intends to measure program performance and improve effectiveness.

To that end, I have joined several colleges in the Legislature to call for an audit. This will provide a roadmap for streamlining the DMV's bureaucracy, establishing better organizational goals, and improving management and services.

Californians deserve an efficient, modern DMV where service is quick, simple, and painless. What they are getting instead is stress, headaches, and lost time. It is past time to change this, and I am calling on all of my colleagues in the Legislature to join our drive to Reform the DMV.

When disaster strikes, will you be ready? Fires, floods, earthquakes or other disasters can strike at any time. How will you keep yourself and your family safe?

Through its CERT program the Sacramento Metropolitan Fire Department (Sac Metro) offers a free 24 hour course in basic disaster preparedness and response. CERT is a nationwide program that trains citizens in such disaster related topics as preparing a 72 hour kit, utility shut off, light search and rescue, basic first aid and the suppression of small fires.

The class offers a chance to practice these skills in a hands on environment with support from both Metro Fire and Metro Fire CERT personnel. The class concludes with a simulated disaster during which participants use their new skills in a collaborative environment.

The main goal of the Basic Class is to help individuals and families be prepared for an emergency. However; upon completion of the introductory 24 hour class participants are eligible to continue on with the program and become active members of the Community Emergency Response Team.

Metro Fire's CERT unit routinely provides standby first aid at large community events, does outreach presentations to community groups, and assists Metro Fire personnel during winter's severe storms or summer's red flag warnings.

The program is currently preparing for the October Basic Class which will be held on

MANGO SALSA

7 ripe mangos
 1 red onion, diced
 1 medium sized jalapeno pepper, diced
 Juice of 4 limes, microwave for 30 seconds for best

juicing

1 bunch cilantro, chopped

If mangos aren't ripe, place them in a brown bag for one day. They need to give a little when gently squeezed to be ripe. If they are soft and squishy, then they are too ripe. Mango cutting tip: slice down toward the pit, do this around the entire mango so that you have several even slices. Then, peel and slice into cubes. This is an easy way to cut up the mango with the large pit and to make evenly cut pieces. Place cut pieces in a bowl, add lime juice and onion. This part can be prepared up to 2 days ahead of time. When ready to serve, add chopped cilantro.

Enjoy with tortilla chips. Mary likes the whole grain scoop style chips. She also uses this salsa with fish (cod) or rice. (Warning: You may not be able to stop eating this salsa!)
