AN OBVIOUS SOLUTION TO A COMPLEX PROBLEM

AN OBVIOUS SOLUTION TO A COMPLEX PROBLEM

Every year, our Sacramento County Sheriff's are receiving more and more dispatch calls for people experiencing a mental health crisis. Unfortunately, far too many of these people don't get the help they need and wind up downtown in the Sacramento County Main Jail for a few days because our officers don't have any other option than to arrest them.

The obvious answer, of course, is to send them support instead of send them to jail - which is exactly what Sacramento County started doing last year when my colleagues and I voted to approve funding for several Mobile Crisis Support Teams (MCSTs). I wanted to take the opportunity this month to explain to you exactly how these MCSTs work, what they have experienced since starting, and how we move forward from here.

Each time a service call comes in through 911 involving someone having a mental health crisis, a Sheriff's car with two people are dispatched to the scene that contains a Sheriff's Deputy trained in crisis intervention training, and a licensed senior mental health counselor. These pairs are permanent partners that ride together in 10 hour shifts.

When the MCST shows up to the scene, they immediately start talking with the person experiencing the crisis to determine what struggles they may have. They go into the situation explaining that they are just there to help, and the mental health counselor often physically shows that they do not carry any weapons on them to calm the situation down.

They are then connecting them to services they may need like drug treatment, the brand new voluntary mental health crisis center, seeing a health counselor, or a variety of other things. A day or two later, a peer navigator is reaching out to them to further help connect them to necessary resources.

One of the teams that I recently spoke with told me that they have already seen the positive impacts of this program. Almost immediately they were reducing unnecessary arrests, decreasing involuntary mental health confinement in our jail, and making a real impact in homelessness (which are around 35-40% of the calls they receive). Non-MCST Sheriff's are even utilizing the program, as when they are out on the scene and see the MCST could be useful, they will call the MCST out to come help them.

The problem the MCST's are facing right now is that there are far too many mental health crisis dispatch calls than they can possibly handle. There are only two teams right now that cover north of the American River, and on top of that, they only work 4 days a week from 9am-7pm. One of those two teams is split between the Cities of Folsom and Citrus Heights. We need these teams to cover

all hours of the day, seven days a week, and we need more of them.

That's why I am pleased to announce that the County is in the midst right now of hiring the senior mental health counselor who will be a part of the third team north of the American River. I recognize that we still need significantly more teams, but it is a step in the right direction and I believe that Orangevale will feel the difference.

Finally, I want to invite everyone to my next Orangevale community meeting on September 12th at 6:00pm at the Orangevale Community Center (6826 Hazel Avenue). This is an opportunity for me to update you on what is going on in the county, and an opportunity for you to ask me questions. According to the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention:

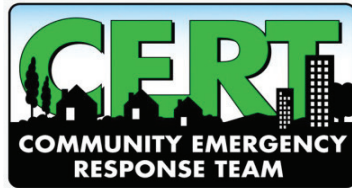
- One in four Americans aged 65+ falls each year.

When disaster strikes, will you be ready? Fires, floods, earthquakes or other disasters can strike at any time. How will you keep yourself and your family safe?

Through it's CERT program the Sacramento Metropolitan Fire Department (Sac Metro) offers a free 24 hour course in basic disaster preparedness and response. CERT is a nationwide program that trains citizens in such disaster related topics as preparing a 72 hour kit, utility shut off, light search and rescue, basic first aid and the suppression of small fires.

The class offers a chance to practice these skills in a hands on environment with support from both Metro Fire and Metro Fire CERT personnel. The class concludes with a simulated disaster during which participants use their new skills in a collaborative environment.

The main goal of the Basic Class is to help individuals and families be prepared for an emergency. However; upon completion of the introductory 24 hour class participants are eligible to continue on with the program and become active members of the Community Emergency Response Team.

Metro Fire's CERT unit routinely provides standby first aid at large community events, does outreach presentations to community groups, and assists Metro Fire personnel during winter's severe storms or summer's red flag warnings.

Three Things Your Garden Needs Before Winter

If you are thinking of putting your home on the market this winter, you may want to make sure that your garden is ready. Keeping that landscaping appeal up through the cold months while buyers are viewing homes may give yours that edge over others on the market. Keep your plants healthy by doing these three things.

WEEDING

Save yourself a lot of work in the spring by pulling out perennial weeds now. Weeds that overwinter in your garden will grow back early the following year, and may even start spreading seeds

before the soil is dry enough to work in. Don't let these plants get established; pull them out now.

WATERING

Even trees and shrubs that lose their leaves need water in the winter. Cold, drying winds can cause damage to plants if they are not able to take up water from the soil. Giving your plants a good soaking will help them survive the winter. The right time to water is after the plants have lost their leaves and gone dormant, but before the ground freezes.

MULCHING

Fall is a great time to add compost around your plants, as the nutrients will begin to soak into the ground as soon as the snow melts in the spring. Adding any kind

of mulch will help protect your plants' roots from cold temperatures. Any plants that are only marginally hardy should have extra mulch to protect them; some gardeners fill pots with dried leaves and place them upside-down over tender plants to give them extra insulation that won't blow away.

When you take the time in the fall to prepare your garden for the winter, you will also be ahead of schedule when spring comes. Keep your plants in good health and save yourself work by weeding, watering and mulching in the fall.

1 package potsticker wrapper
1 tbsp soy sauce
1 tbsp oyster sauce
1 tsp cornstarch

Combine all ingredients in a large bowl. Spoon filling into potsticker wrapper. Brush water in edges of wrapper.

Press to enclose filling.

Spray pan with light cooking spray.

Pour 1/4 cup of chicken broth.

Place potstickers in pan and cook all sides until brown on medium heat. Enjoy!
