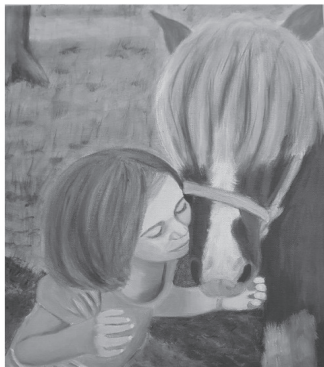

BASIC GUIDELINES FOR SCARECROW

Late Entries will be accepted up to time of judging. Entries must be registered and installed by 5pm, Oct 20, 2018, to be included for Judging. Basic 2x4 frames are recommended. You may have multiple entries (\$10 each).

Scarecrows that are difficult to assemble may still be submitted if they are installed on the designated pole by the maker.

All pieces must be secured so as not to be easily disassembled by the weather.

Names for display are optional. They may include naming the submission, name of maker including business name /phone number/website. These signs must be easily secured to the display pole or the scarecrow as not to create a safety hazard. Suggested is using an 8 1/2x11 laminated sheet stapled to the wood poles or tied to the metal poles. *Duct tape should not be used on the street lighting poles as it will damage the finish.*

You must remove it between November 3rd through the 6th. Any remaining entries will be disposed of.

Organizers may omit a submission if they find the theme offensive or too political.

If entry will be set up by Festival Committee it must be no more than 3 pieces to assemble not including the name sign. Scarecrows will be stored by organizers and reinstalled each year as long as the submission maintains its integrity.

CELEBRATING 100 YEARS

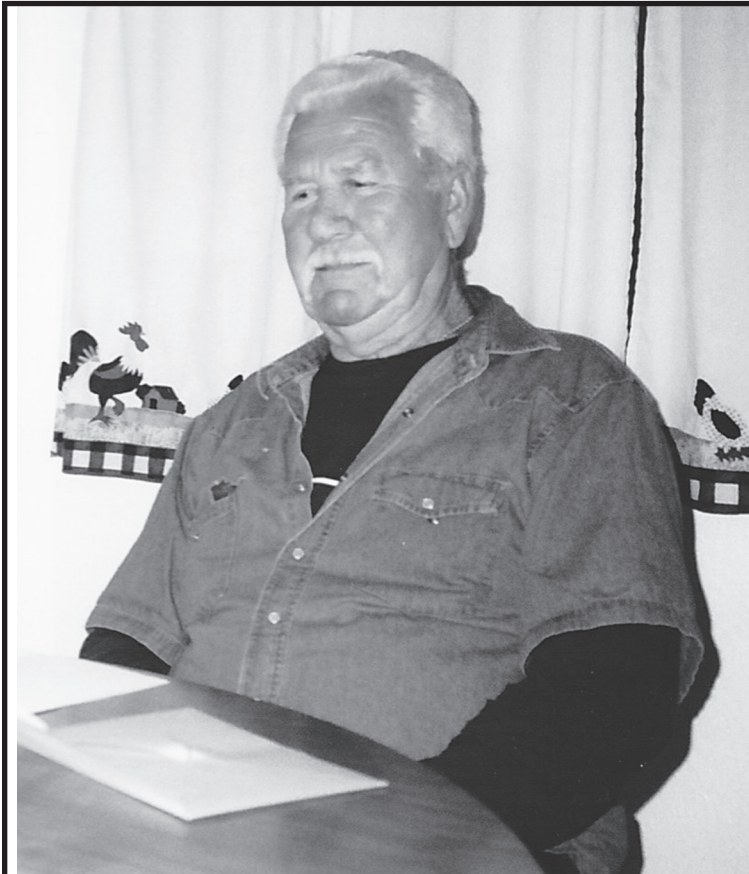

LOOK. LISTEN. LEARN.

As Fire Prevention Week is Approaching, Metro Fire encourages our residents to Look. Listen. Learn.

Fire prevention week was established in 1920 by President Woodrow Wilson to commemorate the Great Chicago Fire of 1871 that took the lives of more than 250 people, left 100,000 homeless, destroyed approximately 17,400 structures, and burned more than 2,000 acres. Since 1922, Fire Prevention Week has been observed on the week of October 9th; the date of the most damage caused by the Great Chicago Fire. In 1925, President Coolidge proclaimed Fire Prevention Week a national observance and is the longest running public health and safety observance on record!

While people feel the safest in their own home, the home is the location in which people are the greatest at risk for fires. In 2016, approximately 352,000 home fires occurred with 2,735 civilian deaths in the United States. During a fire, a few seconds can be the difference between a safe escape or a tragic event occurring. Because everyone is at risk in a fire, it is important for all members of our community to be aware of how to stay safe in case of a fire. Adults, teenagers, and children who have a plan and have practiced a fire escape plan are more prepared and more likely to survive if a home fire were to occur. 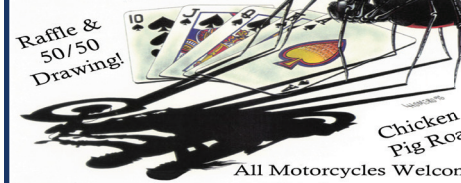

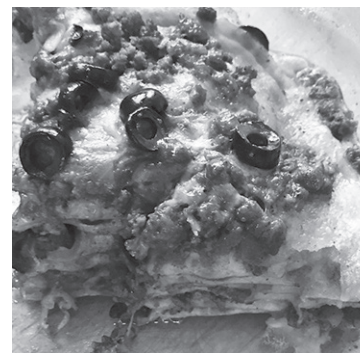

Every Monday my step-mom cooks dinner for the neighbor and his wife who is ill. I happened to call when she was right in the middle of preparing their meal. I asked what it was and it sounded so good that I got the recipe! It is another simple and delicious recipe for this busy time of year. Remember, we are always looking for new menu ideas and since fall is coming, it would be nice to try some new fall recipes.

LAYERED ENCHILADA PIE

1 lb ground beef
1 medium onion, chopped finely
2 tsp salt
¼ tsp pepper
1 TBSP chili powder
1 can tomato sauce, 8 ounces
6 flour tortillas
1 can 4.5 ounces or smaller, sliced olives
1 ½ cups sharp cheddar cheese, grated
1 cup water
• In a large pan, brown beef and onion. Add salt, pepper, chili



powder and tomato sauce; mix together.

- In a 2-quart casserole with a cover to steam, layer a tortilla, meat sauce, olives and cheese. Do this for the 6 tortillas. End up with the meat sauce, olives and cheese on top.
- Pour water over all.
- Bake in a hot oven at 400 degrees for 20 minutes.
- Cut in wedges to serve.

Serve with a salad for a nice meal!

Notes from Suzanne: Try it with just 1 tsp salt first. My step-mom uses fajita sized tortillas and they fit just right in her casserole. I used a larger casserole and used foil because I didn't have a lid and it was a bit watery, but still yummy!! I think you could use a larger tortilla if you wanted to fit your casserole better, but it was nice having the left-over pieces to cover my wedge!
