Separate Divisions are listed for Junior (age 4-13 inclusive), Youth (14-20) and Adult (21+) Exhibitors. The age of the entrant, unless otherwise stated, is based on the participants age at 01/01/2018.

Each Exhibitor is responsible for selecting the appropriate Division for entry, Sections are assigned by age. Pre-registration of entries is required to maintain a smooth check in process for all involved. The Orangevale Chamber of Commerce, Orangevale Grange, Orangevale Town Fair Committee & Exposition Committees are not responsible for errors on entry forms. No exhibitor shall be entitled to an award that has been disallowed because of his/her own error. Entries not meeting contest rules, including labeling, will be disqualified and excluded from

awards.

All entries must be the original work or product of the exhibitor and completed during the contest year. Except for classes using recycled items, materials should be new. Work should be clean and in good repair. Decisions of the judges are recorded on the judging sheets are final. To encourage high standards, the judges shall place exhibits based on merit. Judges may withhold placings as they see fit. Best of Show awards will be awarded at the judge's discretion to superior exhibits. Entry fee is \$5 per item. Judging Systems American: A method of judging in which entries are ranked against each other and the best entries are selected for placing. Normally, only a single 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place award in the class will be awarded. Danish: A method of judging in which entries are compared to a scorecard or standard. As many first placing, etc. as merited will be given. It is important for exhibitors and advisors be familiar with the rules under which these contests are








CELEBRATING THE MARRIAGE OF IAN MICHAEL BRADSHAW AND BRIANNA NICOLE SCHUESSLER.







OV WATER 123RD ANNUAL MEETING

ORANGEVALE WATER COMPANY 123RD ANNUAL MEETING

Having a little free time on a Tuesday afternoon and curious about what the push for turning in my proxy to the Orangevale Water Company was all about. I decided to venture over to the 123rd Annual Orangevale Water Company Board meeting. Not surprisingly, what I found was a group of caring, committed, and long-time Orangevale residents interested in the future of our water company. The focus of the meeting was discussing a year in review under the new management of General Manager, Joe Duran and confirming the incumbent Board members, Jim Lemley, Robert Hunter and Russell Castilone. The Board welcomed the group of attendees and announced having achieved the magic number of required "proxy" votes from Orangevale residents.

Joe Duran began the meeting congratulating the former General Manager, Sharon Wilcox for 47 years of service and praised her dedication and leadership. He also recognized the staff for a smooth management transition and appreciated their support in implementing a host of new initiatives to improve water service for Orangevale residents.

One notable initiative is the ongoing conversion of 5600 smart point readers from a "touch read" to a "drive by reader". This new technology enables a field rep to simply drive by and collect data on a laptop, eliminating the need to physically scan the

meter and will also give customers access to their data as well. To date 356 meters have been converted. Also, other technological advances include a GPS system for updating underground maps. The system will also facilitate quicker response times for service repair requests.

On the list of almost 19 projects completed, all were credited to the OVWC crew except for one, the water main replacement on Central Avenue, which was outsourced due to the terrain and time for completion. According to Duran, "Considering the size of our staff and the scope of the project, the most efficient thing to do was outsource it. We saved both money and time. It was a win win for all."

Other wins of the night included a budget worksheet comparing 2017 to 2018. During his presentation to the Board, Duran proudly shared that, "Any budget item within our control was reduced from the previous year." Duran praised his staff for their hard work and sacrifices in accomplishing all the projects during his first year as General Manager.

Board meetings are held the first Tuesday of the month at 4 pm. Check it out! You'll learn something new and meet some great people. 

I had forgotten this recipe until my husband mentioned it last week. I originally found this recipe while I was watching a daytime talk show. Usually, the recipes are posted on their websites and many times the recipes are different than what is viewed on the show. This recipe was pretty accurate, but I had to replace the main flavor! The recipe is inspired by a Lavender Chicken recipe by Graham Elliot when he was on The Talk. The lavender did not sound good to me, so I replaced it with rosemary. It was so wonderful with the rosemary. I cannot even imagine what lavender would taste like!

ROSEMARY CHICKEN

2 boneless skin-on chicken breasts.

Olive Oil

Butter

Fresh Rosemary- 2-3 sprigs -re-

move from stem Pepper

Salt

Yield 3 servings

- 1. Season chicken with salt and pepper.
- 2. Heat a small amount of olive oil and butter in a skillet over high heat.
- 3. Add chicken skin side down, cook 2 minutes and then reduce heat to medium high; continue cooking skin side down until fat renders and skin is golden brown about 5-10 minutes.
- 4. Turn chicken over and add more butter (1 tablespoon) and the rosemary.
- 5. Continue cooking chicken and add more butter. Spoon the butter and the rosemary over the chicken as it is cooking.
- 6. Check chicken by cutting into the thickest part. If it is still pink, then butterfly the chicken (cut it so it is thinner) and continue spooning the pan juices over it; add more butter if needed. Keep burner at medium or lower so you do not burn the butter.
- 7. When meat is cooked through.

remove from heat.

8. Serve with your favorite potato and a salad.

This makes great leftovers for lunch!

Note: Use skin-on breasts because it keeps the moisture in and the crispy skin is delicious!




