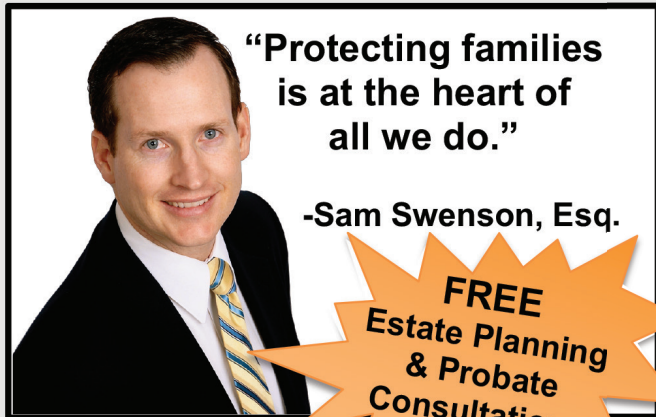

# FULLY FUNDING ROAD REPAIRS

## A BUMPY ROAD TO FULLY FUNDING ROAD REPAIRS

As you are undoubtedly aware, California voters went to the polls last November and voted not to repeal the “gas tax”, which is the largest tax increase in the history of California. The gas tax is here to stay, and local roads in Sacramento County will start getting repaved later this fall. But strangely enough, even though this tax has only been in place for a little over a year, there are local governmental entities currently having discussions about how to raise even more money. I want to take this opportunity to explain to you why this is happening, and where I think we should go from here.

Sacramento County does not have enough money to pay for our roads, and even with the gas tax, we are still dreadfully short of what is needed just to maintain the current awful condition our roads are in. The gas tax was advertised as “fixing our roads”, but in actuality it was just a small drop in the bucket. Right now, even with the gas tax the County would need an additional \$15-20 million yearly just to maintain the roads at their current level. To improve the roads to a standard that people would deem as “good”, we would need an additional \$50 million yearly.

What many people do not understand is that local roads in California used to be primarily funded by the State and Federal government, but over the past several years they have heavily cut back on

local funding. Not only that, but much of the funding that does come in comes in the form of competitive dollars, meaning we are only going to win those funds for major projects that have nothing to do with resurfacing, like the road widening that recently happened along Hazel Avenue.

The problem Sacramento County is experiencing with our roads is not localized to just our county or even region. This is a problem afflicting the entire State of California, as even with the gas tax, our state has around \$85 billion in road maintenance that has been postponed due largely to the State and Federal government diverting funds away from local municipalities. This enormous bill would feel more understandable if California were broke, but that is not the case.

Not only did Governor Newsom just announce a nearly \$15 billion surplus, but after backtracking on some of his comments, he announced that we are still moving forward with California High-Speed Rail (CAHSR). In my opinion, CAHSR is not even a fraction as important as hav-

ing reliable roads. CAHSR will be used exclusively on passengers, with a focus on commuters. Roads meanwhile are used by everyone, including passengers, freight, fire service, police service, etc.

When voters approved CAHSR, it was supposed to cost \$40 billion and connect San Francisco to Los Angeles. Experts are now expecting that it could cost over \$98 billion, but I suspect given how this has been run so far that it would run far higher than that. Governor Newsom made comments recently that he wants to focus on completing the first section, a 188-mile segment between Merced and Bakersfield estimated to cost \$10.6 billion, before moving forward with the full project.

Instead, I suggest we cut our losses, end CAHSR, and finally make real investments to our crumbling infrastructure. Sacramento County cannot afford to let California prioritize a handful of central valley commuters over the needs of virtually every Californian in the State.

From B1&B2 classrooms to Sunday school and now ROTC. When he got the opportunity to work for Casa's ROTC, he took it right away. And up of being a ROTC instructor is that he gets to work with many talented kids, motivated kids, and kids with hearts to serve. Of course I went through some tough times that made me want to quite, but in the end ROTC was there for me, and it became my family. A family that I would be nowhere without. I am truly sad to be graduating, only because I won't be able to go to ROTC everyday and conversate with the people I hold close.

# Orangevale Cooks

It is finally Spring and I think it is time to bake up some yummy desserts! My friend from Maryland has been posting pictures on social media of the goodies that she's been busy baking. I am sharing one of her favorites and most frequently requested recipes. The caramel bits are found with the chocolate chips and are not the kind with a wrapper which makes them much easier to use!

## CARAMEL PECAN BROWNIES

- 1 pkg. Brownie mix (13x9 pan size)
- 2 pkg Kraft Caramel Bits
- 1/3 cup whipping cream
- 2 cups Pecan Halves, divided

- Heat Oven to 350 degrees
- Line 13x9 pan with foil with ends of foil extending over sides.
- Grease foil.
- Prepare brownie mix as directed on package.
- Spread half of batter into prepared pan, covering rest and setting aside.
- Bake 20 minutes, or until top is firm to touch.
- Meanwhile, microwave caramel bits and cream in medium microwaveable bowl on high 2 minutes, stirring every 30 seconds, or until caramel bits begin to melt, stir until completely melted. Then stir in one cup of nuts.
- Spread over brownie layer in pan, cover with remaining brownie batter, some caramel will be showing. Sprinkle with remaining nuts.
- Bake 25 minutes, or until top is firm to touch.
- Cool in pan on wire rack. Lift brownies from pan using foil handles before cutting.
- Store in covered container at room temperature.

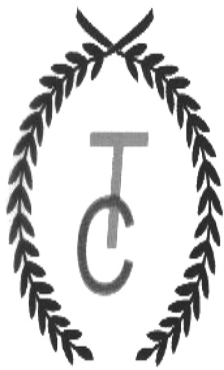

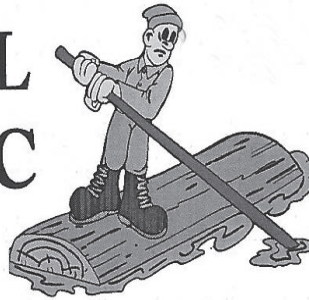

**THE GRANGE**

I've always wondered - what's a Grange? I mean I've heard about the breakfasts they serve, I've attended community events and fundraisers there, but still I wonder "what's a Grange?" Luckily I got a chance to find out more about this very old and unique Orangevale community organization. This is what I found out.

The Grange was the first community center! That's right! It's the place where the local folks would congregate to discuss, socialize, eat, dance and anything else they needed to do together! It was sort of the "hall for everything". Fun fact: the first Orangevale library was established in a Grange member's home who served as the town's librarian for 45 years!

The Orangevale Grange sits on 5 ½ acres of beautiful, lush, rural property in the heart of Orangevale on Walnut Avenue. It's one of the oldest organizations in the community dating back to 1887. Founded by seven members, the Grange has maintained a steady membership over the years and currently has over 120 members.

The Grange is not a business but a member owned, non-profit, grass roots organization. Anyone 14 years or older is welcome to join and gets equal voting rights. Today the Grange still stands firm in its rural roots by supporting farms, providing classes, supporting 4H and Casa FFA. Beyond that, they support the community by annually awarding scholarships to graduating seniors, providing backpacks filled with supplies for elementary and middle school kids and have provided over 13,000 dic-



tionaries to local third grade students in their "Words for Thirds" program.

"We are a motherhood and apple pie organization," said longtime Grange member Bob Clouse. "We are also a family organization and I'm very proud to say that we salute the flag every meeting, say the pledge and have an open bible on the table too."

According to Clouse, family involvement is key to the Grange's future and invites the community to take a look and see what the Grange has to offer and get involved.

Clouse is a prime example of family involvement. He shared an example of the Grange's democratic process and the power of each voting member. Clouse, who has held positions at the state and even National level for the Grange, recounted with affection, a somewhat "humbling" experience as a past Board President.

"I was pushing for a certain initiative and wasn't expecting opposition," reflected Clouse. "Imagine my surprise when my 14 year old son got up, stated his opposing view and won the support of the members!" Clouse was proud of his son and admitted to congratulating him on the drive home.

The Grange is still a meeting place for the community with a fully certified kitchen and an af-

fordable rental facility too. The community is always welcome to join in the many events hosted by the Grange including breakfasts served the second Sunday of every month, and classes on topics like canning and growing tomatoes. There is a sewing and crafters sale coming up April 13. Some of their other popular annual events include a Bunco fundraiser and, the 3rd of July fireworks celebration.

This year they are hosting a few firsts including an Expo, featuring the creative talents of locals for the Orangevale Town Fair May 31 - June 2 (go to orangevalemaintownfair.com for info) and a summer concert series starting May 11 (go to ovsummernights.com). A community garden is also in the works out back so stay tuned to the Grange website for more info.

"We are excited about hosting these upcoming events and hope the community will come be a part of it," said Board member Jim Beilgard. "Our hope is to rejuvenate interest in the Grange and give the community a chance to come see and enjoy our beautiful property."

Beilgard invited anyone interested in learning more about the Grange to come to one of the monthly meetings held on the third Wednesday of every month. The meetings start at 7 p.m., but newcomers are invited to come at 6:30 pm for a little "meet and greet". In February the Interact Club voted to award Saint John's

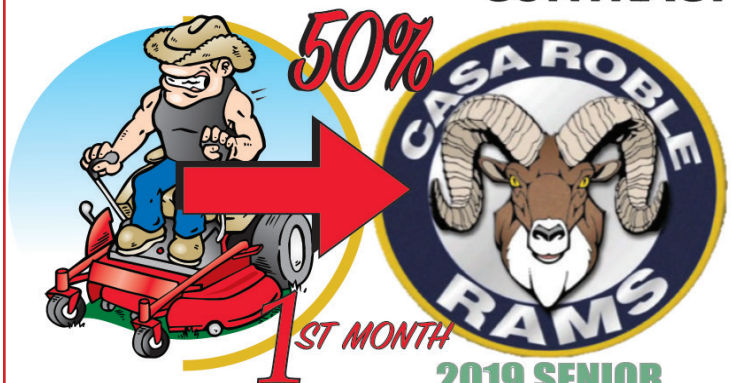

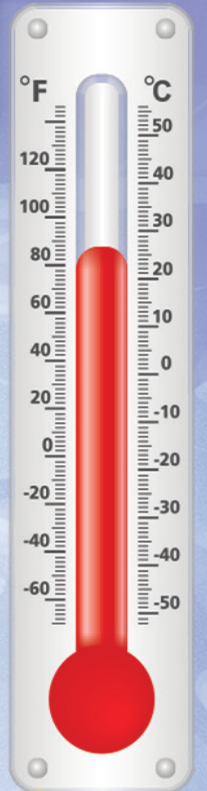
