RESOLUTION NO. 19-05-618

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ORANGEVALE RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT APPROVING THE RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO LEVY ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20, PRELIMINARILY APPROVING THE ENGINEER'S REPORT AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE ORANGEVALE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT (OLLAD)

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Orangevale Recreation and Park District, County of Sacramento, State of California, has previously ordered through Resolution 92-06-51 the formation of an assessment district pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 for the purpose of financing certain park and recreation improvements and refurbishments as specified in the District's updated Master Plan and for the purpose of funding maintenance operations of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board, through Resolution 92-06-51, has ordered that the park and recreation improvements specified in the Engineer's Report dated March 26, 1992, be constructed, and has estimated that the cost of such proposed park and recreation improvements is greater than can be raised from a single annual assessment, and has ordered that the estimated costs of these improvements be raised by an assessment levied and collected in annual installments over a period of 20 years, commencing in fiscal year 1992-93 and ending in fiscal year 2012-13 and then continued from year to year as necessary to fund other capital, maintenance and other needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Orangevale Recreation and Park District, County of Sacramento, State of California, that:

1. On July 17, 1991, by its Resolution No. 816, this Board ordered the formation of and levied the first assessment within the Orangevale Recreation and Park District Maintenance Assessment District 1991 (the "Assessment District") pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972.

2. On March 14, 2019 this Board adopted Resolution No. 19-03-614, A Resolution Directing Preparation of the 2019-20 Annual Report for the Orangevale Recreation and Park District Maintenance Assessment District. Pursuant to this resolution, SCI Consulting Group, the Engineer of Work, prepared a report in accordance with Article XIID of the California Constitution and Section 22565, et seq., of the California Streets and Highways Code (the "Report"). The Report has been made, filed with the Clerk of the Board and duly considered by the Board and is hereby deemed sufficient and preliminarily approved. The Report shall stand as the Engineer's Report for all subsequent proceedings under and pursuant to the foregoing resolution.

3. It is the intention of this Board to levy and collect assessments within the Assessment District for fiscal year 2019-20. Within the Assessment District, the existing and proposed improvements, and any substantial changes proposed to be made to the existing improvements, are generally described as installation, maintenance and servicing of public recreational facilities and improvements, including, but not limited to, turf and play areas, landscaping, ground cover, shrubs and trees, irrigation systems, drainage systems, lighting, fencing, entry monuments, basketball courts, tennis courts, gymnasium, running tracks, swimming pools, other recreational facilities, security patrols to protect the Improvements, graffiti removal and repainting, and labor, materials, supplies, utilities and equipment, as applicable, at each of the locations owned, operated or maintained by the Orangevale Recreation and Park District.

4. The Assessment District consists of the lots and parcels shown on the boundary map of the Assessment District on file with the Clerk of the Board of the Orangevale Recreation and Park District, and reference is hereby made to such map for further particulars.

5. Reference is hereby made to the Engineer's Report for a full and detailed description of the improvements, the boundaries of the Assessment District and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the Assessment District. The Engineer's Report identifies all parcels which will have a special benefit conferred upon them and upon which an assessment will be imposed.

6. The assessments are not proposed to increase from the previous year's assessments. The Board of Directors declares its intent to levy and collect assessments for the fiscal year 2019-20 within said district at an assessment rate of \$3.50 per month or \$42.00 per year per single family residential parcel, apartment unit and/or condominium; a lower rate of \$3.08 per month or \$36.96 per year per each mobile home unit or per one-quarter acre parcel devoted to commercial use; and a rate of \$1.40 per month or \$16.80 per year per one-quarter acre for parcels devoted to industrial or mini storage use, all as set forth in the benefit chart included in the Engineer's Report.

7. Notice is hereby given that on June 13, 2019, at the hour of 6:30 p.m. at the District offices of the Orangevale Recreation and Park District, 6826 Hazel Avenue, California 95662, the Board will hold a public hearing to consider the ordering of the improvements and the levy of the proposed assessments.

8. Prior to the conclusion of the hearing, any interested person may file a written protest with the Clerk of the Board, or, having previously filed a protest, may file a written withdrawal of that protest. A written protest shall state all grounds of objection. A protest by a property owner shall contain a description sufficient to identify the property owned by such owner. Heather Moody Named as New American River College Women's Water Polo Coach Brings Olympic Experience, Deep Coaching Background

American River College (ARC) has welcomed Heather Moody as Head Women's Water Polo coach, with plans to start in Fall 2019.

"ARC is very excited to have Heather join the Beaver athletics family," said Der-

rick Booth, ARC Athletics Dean. "She brings outstanding experience both as a coach and as a player. We can't wait to have Heather start working with our student-athletes. We think she is going to accomplish great things with our student-athletes."

Moody is accomplished as both a player and a coach. As a player, she won a Silver Medal at the 2000 Games and captained the U.S. to a Bronze Medal finish in 2004. Moody also led the Americans to gold medals at the 2003 FINA World Championships in Barcelona and at the 2003 Pan American Games in the Dominican Republic. As a member of San Diego State's water polo team, Moody led the Aztecs to a third-place finish at the 1996 Collegiate National Championship in her only season with the Aztecs. Moody was named a first-team All-American that year and was the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation's Co-Player of the Year. In addition to being a two-time United States Water Polo Player of the Year (1999, 2001), Moody was also one of the first women to be elected into the New York

Athletic Club Hall of Fame

As impressive as her playing career has been, she has had great success as a water polo coach at every level of the sport. Following her playing career, she served on the United States coaching staff as an assistant for the 2008 Olympic team, helping lead the team to a Silver Medal in Beijing, and on the Gold Medal-winning staff in 2012 in London. She also led the US National team to a Silver Medal finish at the 2005 FINA World Championships as the interim head coach. Most recently, Moody led the St. Francis High School program for six seasons from 2013-18. The Troubadours advanced to the Sacramento Section playoffs in each of her six seasons, winning the title in 2015 and reaching the finals five times overall. She has coached 19 student-athletes to 28 All-Section honors, four All-Americans and 18 USA Water Polo Academic All-Americans.

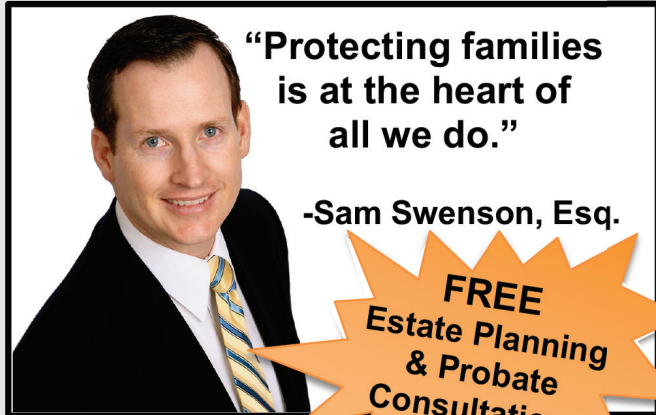

FOUR LOCAL GIRLS ARE GOING TO GIRLS STATE

The American Legion Auxiliary (ALA) Units in all 50 states proudly host ALA Girls State. Each year the ALA invites local high schools to participate in the Girls State (G.S.) Program. G.S. is designed for girl in their junior year of high school. Each year we select one girl from each participating school as our Delegate and one as the alternates. Girls State is a week long program where the girls learn about the political process by selecting officials for all levels of state government and actively run a mock government. Assistance from dedicated ALA volunteers ensures the programs nonpartisan governmental, patriotic and civic objectives are carried out through interactive learning. Girls State is a practical application of Americanism and good citizenship. Girls State was established in 1937 by the National Convention as an attempt to teach and inculcate in the youth of America a love of God and Country. 182 years later Girls State is still going strong and providing young women from around the United State an opportunity to pursue their interest in government and current event. Most of these young ladies have strong interest in government, law, and military pursuits. These young ladies go through a competitive selection process; application with a professional resume, then followed up with a panel interview. Even if the girls are not chosen for delegate or alternated this interview process is a great



life lesson. This year ALA Fair Oak, Unit 383 along with Folsom American Legion Post 362 will be sending four local girls to Girls State; Bella Vista, Kate Schlenker, Casa Roble, Savannah Argo. Folsom High, Scarlett M Kniznik, and Vista Del Lago, Anoushka Ambavanekar. We interview over 20 girls this year, all of who were qualified to represent us at Girls State. This is always a very hard decision to make that we do not take lightly. There will be over 500 girls in attendance this year. ALA District 6 has 7 units in the

Sacramento area, and each unit will be sending juniors from local high schools. Girls State is held the last week in June from 24th to 29th at Claremont McKenna College in Claremont California. Girls State is a very protégés program and has helped to open many doors and present opportunities for their future. One of our delegates from last year, Folsom High School senior Tessa Bomke, will be attending West Point next year. All of our delegates from last year have been excepted to the college of their choice.

It is with great pride that ALA Fair Oaks, unit 383 along with The American Legion (TAL) Folsom Post 362 are able to support Girls State and the advancement of our youth.

WRITING WITH KRIS

When Kris Cordell gathered a few of her children's friends in her home in Orangevale sixteen years ago, no one would have suspected it to flourish and grow into the successful homeschool program now called Writing with Kris.

Writing with Kris teaches students of all ages to express themselves in writing. Cordell's signature classes are literature-based classes which blend analyses of classic literature with writing, in addition to classes in journalism, research writing, story writing, poetry, and many more.

"I enjoy being able to give students tangible tools to help them express their ideas correctly and effectively," says Cordell, "I also enjoy supporting parents who see the need to help their children communicate well both verbally and in writing, yet they feel inadequate."

Cordell provides writing instruction

for students, parents, and teachers with her on-site, online, and one on one tutoring lessons. Presently, Cordell and her teachers serve approximately 200 students, locally and across the nation, including students in Venezuela and Pakistan. Her clients are primarily homeschooled students, but many traditionally schooled students participate as well. She and her staff of teachers go to several on sight locations in the greater Sacramento area such as local libraries and churches. Classes are typically once a week for two hours. Currently, summer classes will be offered to anyone interested and the details for the fall schedule will be finalized this summer. Cordell finds running Writing with Kris greatly rewarding.

"I enjoy providing students with practical writing skills for education, careers, and life," she says. Cordell is married with four children of her own. She obtained her education from San Diego Christian

College and "as a country girl at heart, Orangevale feels rural but it's not far from the city."

Welcoming building stands on the side of the road where dozens of hungry people gather and eagerly await to be fed. Amidst the busy volunteers and recipients stands Keith Wright, who has been the director of the Orangevale foodbank for the past five years. The food bank was founded six and a half years ago by Brad Squires, a member of the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce. The mission of the organization is "to make a positive impact on the communities of Orangevale and Fair Oaks by providing food, resources, and hope to families in need," says Wright. "We also strive to facilitate participation from the people within our community to help improve the lives of families in need through community outreach events, volunteering, food drives, and connecting people through a common purpose."

The food bank serves both new and repeat residents from Orangevale and Fair Oaks who may visit the food bank once per month and receive about a week's worth of groceries based upon the size of their family. Many of the people in need that are served are going through a difficult economic time or are retired older residents who live on a fixed

income. This summer, the food bank will be launching a program for children that receive free or reduced lunches during the school year.

"The food bank will be filling in the gap," stated Wright who explained that the long term vision for the food bank is "to make it a hub where we can provide other social services as well, to meet more of the needs of people that are going through a hard economic time."

According to Wright, the food bank is in desperate need of volunteers to help during food drives, due to a large number of products being handled and families being served. They also have local farmers who are willing to donate their harvest and need people who can pick it.

Being such a large workplace, the Orangevale Food Bank is in need of skilled volunteers to help with a variety of projects, such as installing a water heater, repairing door locks and other maintenance issues.

"When people volunteer, they unite as a community, you become like a family and form strong friendships," says Wright. "It allows people to help those in need and gain purpose from it."

Any Orangevale or Fair Oaks residents interested in volunteering or obtaining services can go to the food bank located at 6483 Main Ave,

Orangevale, CA 95662 on Mondays between 11pm-1pm, Wednesdays between 4:30-6:30, and Thursdays between 10 am- 12:30 pm. Residents seeking food services need to provide Identification for themselves as well as the people in their family and proof of residence such as a utility bill. 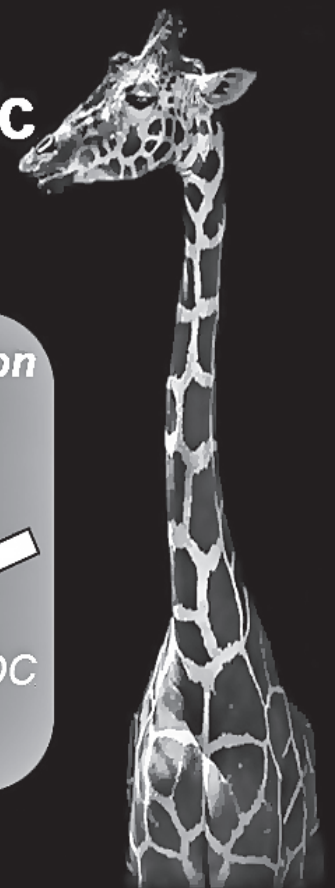

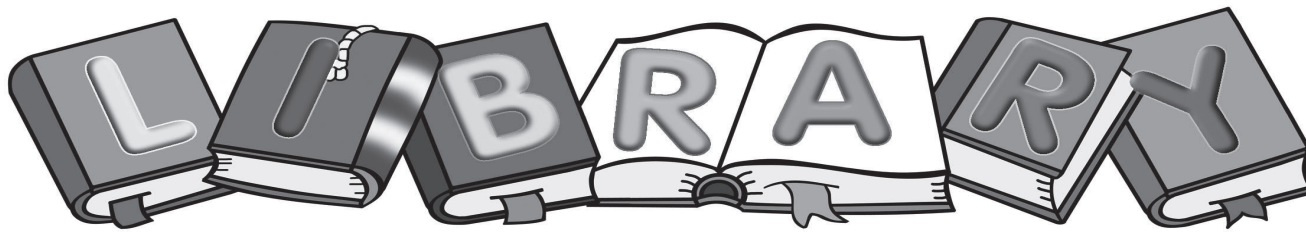

Spaghetti is such an easy and delicious dinner for any season of the year and we all have a favorite recipe. Some of us enjoy opening a jar of prepared sauce, some of us "doctor" our favorite prepared sauces and some of us use tomatoes from the garden. I have a simple recipe that is homemade, but uses canned tomato products. I obtained this recipe from my mom and I have been using it for over 30 years. When I have an abundance of tomatoes in the garden, I usually use them instead of the canned tomatoes. I have used this recipe for a vegetarian sauce without the meat and I have used this sauce with polenta and cheese instead of the spaghetti. It is an easy and versatile sauce and there are no hidden ingredients. Enjoy!

SIMPLE SPAGHETTI SAUCE

- 3Tbsp olive oil (optional)
- 1 lb ground beef
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 clove garlic, minced or pressed
- 1-6 ounce can tomato paste
- 1-8 ounce can tomato sauce
- 1-14 ounce can tomatoes
- 1 TBSP sugar
- 2 tsp Italian seasoning
- Salt- to taste
- Pepper- to taste

Cook onion and garlic in olive oil until golden. Add ground beef and brown. If you want to save on calories, brown the ground beef and add the onion and garlic while you are browning. Drain fat from pan. Add the rest of the ingredients and simmer 40 minutes.

Serve with your choice of pasta or use with polenta (see bag of polenta for instruction) and mozzarella and jack cheese. When using with polenta, put one slice of jack cheese on the plate, add a serving of prepared polenta, then the sauce and top with a slice of mozzarella. Yummy!

This recipe will make enough sauce for one pound of spaghetti.
