So, on a warm early afternoon, the guest of honor, Doris, along with her immediate family, staff and fellow residents of Almond Heights, all socially distanced, enjoyed beautiful jazz music by local musician Chaz, playing trumpet, accompanied by Bill, who played keyboard. Julie King, Orangevale's Honorary Mayor, wished Doris a very happy birthday on behalf of the community and then read a proclamation from County Supervisor Sue Frost in honor of Doris's special milestone.

Since an in person interview was not an option, I decided to ask Doris a few questions via email, this is what she had to share:

Doris grew up in Oregon; her family was poor during the Depression. She tells tales of her and her older sister having to

prove at the ages of 12 and 13, that they could lift a ladder next to a cherry tree to pick the cherries. Doris and her siblings also lived with her grandparents during this time and picked string beans to earn money for their family.

When she graduated from high school, she had to borrow money from the school fund for her graduation formal.

When Doris was 20, she traveled to Castro Valley California to visit her aunt and attend the World's Fair in San Francisco. She was introduced to her husband Herb, at this time, who was a friend of her Aunt's neighbor. He later sent for her after she had returned home to Oregon. They were married in Reno. Doris tells a tale of her future mother in law being so happy that her son was to be married; apparently, (her mother in law) felt at age 28, he would never marry.

When Herb proposed, he asked her if she wanted a diamond ring, she replied, "I would rather have a stove!" Doris stated, "How foolish that sounds now!" The couple bought their first home in Oakland, CA for \$5000.00.

What are Doris' secrets for a happy life and making it to 100? "Hard work, do not expect too much and give to others."

Doris has lived at Almond Heights since May of 2018. She feels fortunate to live there and loves to be "waited on".

RESTORING CHECKS AND BALANCES

RESTORING CHECKS AND BALANCES

Separation of powers is one of the first lessons taught in civics class. It's foundational to our form of government. By spreading powers among different actors and institutions, it was our Founders' most important innovation for safeguarding individual liberty.

But California has forgotten that lesson these last few months. Since he ordered a Stay at Home Order in March, Governor Newsom has issued 45 Executive Orders, unilaterally changing over 220 duly enacted laws.

While the Governor is granted additional authority during a State of Emergency, many of these decrees fall outside the bounds of the public health threat. For example, one order altered liability rules for businesses; another overhauled an election that was still 5 months away. This has sparked bipartisan protest. One leading Democratic Assembly Member decried the Governor's "complete authority to do whatever he wants."

With one branch of government, the Executive, repeatedly stepping into the territory of a second, the Legislative, my colleague James Gallagher and I turned to the third branch: the Judiciary. On June 12, we filed a legal challenge in Superior Court to restore the appropriate balance of power.

Our challenge was successful. The Court issued a temporary restraining order that suspends the Governor's most recent Executive Order, and further restrains him from "exercising any further legislative powers in violation of the California Constitution and applicable statute, specifically from unilaterally amending, altering, or changing existing statutory law or making new statutory law."

A cavalcade of lawyers with the Attorney General's Office has since arrived on the scene, hoping to reverse the Court's order. Their arguments all seek to expand, rather than rein in, executive authority. For instance,

they argue that allowing the legislative process to work as intended would cause "uncertainty and delays." But this is a feature of our system, not a bug: it was exquisitely designed to prevent the swift passage of new laws so the powers of government cannot be exercised without thoughtful consideration.

The Attorney General also argues the invalidated Executive Order was "essential" to "protecting Californians from further harm by the COVID-19 pandemic." While this was true of certain executive actions specifically related to public health, it is not the case for many other orders. That's an important distinction: Claiming a public health justification for actions that plainly lack one weakens our ability to build trust for policies that are genuinely needed to address COVID-19 or future health threats.

Our Founders understood that strong executive actions might from time to time be needed to confront emergencies. But they also believed checks and balances should never be a casualty of a crisis. It's time to restore the proper constitutional balance in California government.

OV Unplugged

Hello Orangevale and surrounding communities! We hope you enjoyed our Pollinator Scavenger Hunt from our last issue! We loved hearing from the community and seeing what families were able to find. In this issue of OV Unplugged we challenge our readers to put down the electronics and head outside to find as many local birds as you can, using CNP's Bird Scavenger Hunt. This screen-free challenge will keep your eyes peeled towards the sky and trees; although the Turkey may be easily found walking in our local Orangevale neighborhoods.

Did you know that birds play a critical role in our natural environment? They sure do, for example birds are responsible for spreading plant seeds, pollinating flowering plants, controlling insect and animal pests, reducing weeds, reducing disease and cleaning up waste

from other animals, as well as singing sweet melodies for our ears, and so much more! The birds listed on our scavenger hunt are easily found in our area; many of which our Playschoolers see on a daily basis in our outdoor certified classroom. This scavenger hunt also has a special challenge listed which includes finding a bird's nest or creating a bird feeder. If you choose to make a bird feeder this could be accomplished by purchasing one or using materials from around your home. One way to create a bird feeder is to use a left over toilet paper roll, peanut butter, and birdseed. Another way to make a bird feeder is by utilizing an old sock, jersey, or pantyhose and filling it with bird seed. Once completed hang these bird feeders with string from a tree, a portion of your home, or the patio. Other ways you could help our local birds could include putting nesting materials outside such as lint from the dryer or animal fur, in addition to placing bird baths outdoors and

planting trees to help our feathered friends. For more information about the 255 native birds in Sacramento County visit the Sacramento Audubon Society at www.Sacramento-Audubon.org.

Birds are an intricate part of our environment and helping them thrive, especially in the winter months when food is scarce, is helpful to these amazing creatures whom in so many ways help conserve our natural environment. 

Orangevale Cooks

It is summer and I have a great summer recipe for you from a reader! Lucille Wong sent in her Chinese Chicken Salad recipe. Last week I made it for my family and everyone loved it! It will be one of my favorite salads this summer. I have always wanted to use those rice sticks and this recipe calls for it. They are fun to cook and delicious!

(Do you remember the movie from the '80's called Mr. Mom with Michael Keaton? He was making dinner using these rice sticks and he put the entire package in and they expanded very quickly. These are what you are using in this recipe!)

Chinese Chicken Salad
 1 package rice sticks
 1 head of lettuce
 1 bunch of green onions
 4 fried chicken thighs
 Vegetable oil for frying

Dressing:

2 Tbsp sesame seeds
 2 Tbsp white sugar
 1 tsp salt
 3 Tbsp white vinegar
 ¼ cup vegetable oil
 1 tsp Accent flavor en-

hancer

In a 4 quart pot, put about 2 inches of oil. Heat on medium high heat. Break up rice sticks. Put a small strand in to see if the oil is hot enough. When it sizzles and puffs up, it is ready. Put a small amount of the rice sticks in the oil at a time. (Do not add the whole thing at one time.) It will puff up, then cook it until it is golden brown. Cook enough to make 1 bowl equal to your lettuce. Drain on paper towels until ready to add to lettuce. Shred lettuce to make 1 bowl of lettuce. Cut 3 stalks of green onion diagonally to the white part. Add to lettuce. Shred chicken, making sure to take off the fat pieces, skin and bone. Add to salad.

In a larger bowl mix this with the cooked rice sticks. Toss with dressing. Enjoy!

Suzanne's Notes: I did not use Accent in my dressing because this is MSG and some people are sensitive to it. I found the rice sticks in the ethnic aisle of the grocery store. The brand that I found was Dynasy Maifan rice sticks. I wasn't going to fry up some thighs, so I got them in the deli warm food section of the grocery store! Oh, and I toasted the sesame seeds. This salad is for a large family or small gathering. I made half the recipe for my adult family of 3.

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEMBER TED GAINES CRITICIZES GAS TAX INCREASE

State Board of Equalization Member Ted Gaines issued the following statement on the July 1 gas tax increase of three cents per gallon:

"California already had among the highest gas taxes in the country before the state Legislature passed SB 1 and essentially guaranteed increasing gas taxes every year. But we also had some of the worst roads. That's a rotten combination for taxpayers, who have gotten no value from their government.

"Before raising taxes a single penny, legislators should have reformed labor and environmental rules that make California road building so incredibly expensive compared to other states. They should have redirected the billion dollars a year of diverted weight fees to road maintenance and construction. And they should have prioritized practical road building over high-speed rail service that most drivers will never use but will pay for.

"But instead of reforms or cost savings, they just reached their hands deeper into taxpayers' wallets.

"Three cents a gallon might not break the bank itself, but when you add it to our highest-in-the-nation sales tax, astronomical rents and housing costs, and electricity rates that are 50 percent higher than the national average, it adds up to a cost-of-living nightmare for California families and businesses.

"With California's unemployment rate at its highest level since the Great Recession in 2010, I can't imagine a more ill-advised time to make daily life even more expensive, when families are simply trying to pay rent and keep food on the table.

"California politicians shouldn't be filling up their own tanks while family budgets are running on empty. Drivers were already paying nearly 80 cents a gallon in combined state and federal taxes before today's increase. We can build better infrastructure and a brighter future for our state with existing revenues and without higher taxes, at the pump or anywhere else."



While COVID-19 first appeared in the United States at the beginning of this year, most of us in Orangevale didn't really see the effects until a few months later. Many high school students struggled with this change to their educational routine.

In addition to transforming the high school learning environment, the global pandemic led to the cancelation of all sports, both at the high school level and the professional level. For student athletes playing spring sports, this was devastating.

Despite all of the turmoil and change of this year, teens maintained hope that life would return to normal. It didn't. When it was announced that prom and graduation would be unable to proceed normally as in previous years, high school seniors were shocked. Still, the perseverance of young adults is unparalleled. Casa arranged a virtual graduation, and students planned a backyard prom in June.

Even months into the pandemic, our lives aren't back to normal, and us teenagers are beginning to learn to accept the new reality of life. Summer seems to be canceled, with social distancing measures still in place, unsafe travel opportunities and many businesses that are still shut down. There is also uncertainty regarding the upcoming school year. Most colleges have announced that they will be continuing distance learning for the fall semester. High schools are proposing a model involving attending school only a few days a week.

No matter what continues to happen, we know that our experiences as teenagers during a global pandemic is unique and giving up our daily routine is a small sacrifice if it can protect the lives of others in our community and worldwide.
