IT'S TIME FOR THE LEGISLATURE TO GET TO WORK

Earlier this month the Legislature reconvened for the 2021-2022 Session. Yet after a three-month absence, the Legislature only stuck around for a single day to re-install its existing leadership.

It's no secret that I have taken issue with the Legislature's handling of the COVID-19 crisis. As grocery clerks, construction workers, child-care providers, and millions of other Californians kept doing essential jobs, Legislators refused to do theirs. The Capitol was shut down entirely for months and almost all hearings were cancelled. Our institution vanished, deeming itself inessential, and left the people of California bereft of the fundamental protections that representative government is supposed to provide.

In our absence, Governor Newsom seized legislative power for himself, falsely claiming that a State of Emergency, no matter how long it lasts, transforms California into an autocracy and "centralizes the State's powers" in his hands. The results were catastrophic. Our economy is doing about the worst in the country, our kids in poor communities are faring worst of all, and our public health performance is middling.

If the Legislature had taken its job seriously, if we had defended our Constitution and met the challenges of this year head-on, things could have been very different. We could have built up our hospital capacity, supported our health care workers, and protected the vulnerable. We could have averted the EDD train wreck that kept food off of the table for millions of Californians. From the beginning, we could have insisted on data and evidence, focused on what actually makes a difference, and avoided the never-ending nightmare of colors, tiers, curfews, and lockdowns.

While we cannot redo 2020, this Session provides the Legislature with an opportunity to reassert itself and restore representative government. It's time to work together to rebuild trust and forge a better path forward for all Californians.

To that end, I have immediately introduced the following legislation:

1. Opening Businesses: AB 54 prohibits state agencies from revoking any business license for non-compliance with shutdown orders without first proving the business was actually a cause of widespread transmission.

2. Opening Schools: AB 76 assures every California child is given the option of full in-person instruction without further delay.

3. Reforming the Emergency Services Act: AB 69 provides that a State of Emergency expires after 60 days unless renewed by the Legislature, rather than continuing indefinitely.

4. Repealing AB 5: AB 25 repeals the rest of AB 5 now that voters have overwhelmingly rejected the premise of this corrupt law by passing Prop. 22.

5. Fixing the EDD: I have co-authored a package of bills to get payments to those in need more efficiently, protect sensitive applicant information, and eliminate fraud.

While these are most assuredly challenging times, I hope you have a wonderful holiday season. I look forward to working to finally get our state on track in the New Year.

HOLIDAY TIPS FOR PET OWNERS

Here are 10 ways to keep your pets safe during the upcoming holiday festivities:

1.The New Pet

Holidays are not the best time to introduce a new pet to the household. All the excitement, noise and deviation from the normal routine could make it difficult for a new pet—and any existing pets—to make the adjustment.

2.Pets as Gifts

Consider seriously the choice to give a pet as a gift. One of the main reasons animals are abandoned or taken to shelters is because they are unwanted. Don't contribute to this situation by giving a pet to someone who may not want it or be able to care for it. If you do choose to give a pet as a gift, allow the recipient(s) to select the pet so that they can find one that is right for them.

3.Food, Chocolate & Treats

Keep holiday treats and candies out of your pet's reach as they can make your pet quite sick. Candy wrappers can cause digestive upset if eaten.

Potentially harmful foods include: coffee grounds, chocolate, tea, alcohol, hops, salt, onions and onion powder, grapes and raisins, avocado, garlic, and macadamia nuts.

Chocolate, particularly unsweetened, dark, bittersweet and baking chocolate, can be toxic to pets, especially dogs, who are more prone to eat it. If your dog eats chocolate, call your veterinarian or an animal poison control center immediately, as treatment may need to be rendered immediately. Symptoms of toxicity include excitement, nervousness, trembling, vomiting, diarrhea, excessive thirst or urination, muscle spasms and seizures.

Keep gum, candy or breath fresheners containing the sweetener xylitol away from your dog. When a dog eats even a small amount of xylitol, it causes a surge of insulin, and the animal's blood sugar may drop quickly and dangerously. Cases of liver damage have also been associated with ingestion of xylitol. If your dog ingests xylitol, contact your veterinarian or an animal poison control center immediately.

4.Leftovers

Don't feed your pet holiday turkey or chicken, as the small bones or fragments can lodge in the throat, stomach, or intestinal tract. Fatty leftovers such as turkey skin can trigger inflammation of the pancreas (pancreatitis), a life threatening disease. At the very least, too much human food may give your pet an upset stomach.

5.Guests

Pets can become overexcited, confused or frightened by holiday guests. Keep pets in a quiet part of the house. When guests are over, watch for open doors and make sure your pets have ID tags and/or microchips in case they do get out. Remind your guests that your normally friendly pet may want to be left alone. Pets may be scared of trick-or-treaters in costume. Young trick-or-treaters may be scared of dogs who run excitedly toward them when the owner puts the door. Outdoor pets, especially black cats, should be kept indoors on Halloween.

6.Christmas Tree

Make sure your tree is well secured. Avoid adding preservatives, aspirin or sugar to your tree's water, or keep the water covered. Tidy up around your tree and wreaths as sharp pine needles can puncture your pet if ingested.

7.Holiday Decorations

Holiday decorations such as breakable ornaments and dreidels should be kept out of reach of pets, as should fake cobwebs, tinsel, string, and ribbon. If your pet ingests any of these items, it could experience serious internal injuries, or worse. Light strands, loose wires and electric cords can be a serious hazard to your pet, especially puppies, who may chew them.

8.Plants

Mistletoe and holly are poisonous and should be kept out of reach of pets. If eaten, poinsettia plants can cause severe gastrointestinal upset. You may want to avoid these other poisonous plants.

9.Candles

Never leave candles unattended, especially around puppies and kittens.

10.Stress

The holidays can be a stressful time for everyone, even your pets. Even though your routine

might change, try to keep your pets on their normal routine of feeding and exercise. Some pets might not mind "dressing up" but, for others, it could be a stressful experience best avoided.





IF you need a yummy holiday breakfast treat, I have this yummy recipe from my sister. I have shared it before, but I think it would be perfect for this year because most of us will have smaller family gatherings. The best part of the recipe is that you prepare this the night before so that all you have to do is put it in the oven in the morning.

DOGGONE BIRTHDAY CAKE

Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/4 cup softened margarine
- 1/4 cup corn oil
- (1) 3.5oz jar strained beef (baby food) or strained chicken
- 1 cup shredded carrots
- 3 eggs
- 2 strips bacon fried and crumbled or may use dog beef jerky

* plain yogurt for icing or cottage

JENNY'S CRÈME BRULEE FRENCH TOAST

- 1/2 cup unsalted butter
- 1 cup brown sugar, packed
- 2 TBSP corn syrup
- 6 French bread slices (buy an inexpensive unsliced loaf of French bread and trim off the crust, then slice the bread into slices of about 1 1/2 inches thick)
- 5 eggs
- 1 1/2 cups half-and-half cream
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 tsp brandy-based orange liqueur (like a Grand Marnier-type)-optional
- 1/4 tsp salt

Melt butter in a small pan over medium heat. Mix in sugar and corn syrup, stirring until sugar is dissolved. Pour into a 9 x 13 inch baking dish.

Arrange the sliced, crust less bread in the baking dish in a single layer. In a small bowl, whisk together eggs, cream, vanilla, brandy, and salt. Pour over the bread. Cover and chill at least 8 hours or overnight.

In the morning, preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Remove the French toast from the refrigerator and bring to room temperature.

Bake uncovered 35-40 minutes until puffed and lightly browned.

Serve immediately. This is delicious with a side of fresh raspberries or your favorite fruit. Serves 6.

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Grease and flour an 8-inch round pan. Cream butter until smooth. Add corn oil, baby food, eggs, and carrots. Mix until smooth. Gradually adding flour and baking powder, continue to mix until smooth. Add crumbled bacon (or beef jerky) and fold into batter. Pour batter into greased round cake pan. Bake time: 60 -70 minutes (depending on your

oven - cake should bounce back). Let cool. Top with plain yogurt or cottage cheese. Refrigerate any remaining portions.

Editor's Note: Read the label of the baby food jars to be sure they don't contain Onion Powder. There have been cases where cats developed onion toxicosis after eating baby food. Avoid Garlic and Garlic powder as well.


