## A LOCAL COMMUNITY WITH DEEP AGRICULTURAL ROOTS IS RECONNECTING WITH ITS GARDENING INSTINCTS.



A local community with deep agricultural roots is reconnecting with its gardening instincts.

On Saturday, April 17, the Orangevale Grange will unveil its new COMMUNITY garden with an official grand opening and ribbon cutting with Sacramento County Supervisor Sue Frost. Supervisor Frost was instrumental in obtaining the grant to start the garden project. That same morning, the new Orangevale Grange Farm and Garden Club will hold its first meeting.

Also on the same morning, the new Orangevale-Fair Oaks Food Bank Farm hosted its first plant sale with plenty of seedlings, ready to go in the ground.

These inaugural events celebrate what most Orangevale residents know: It's a great place to grow food.

"Orangevale is a farm community, full of home and backyard gardeners," says Jim Beilgard, who serves as garden project coordinator for the Orangevale Grange. "The Grange sits on a 6-acre piece of glorious property in the center of Orangevale. Grange members have been discussing the importance of getting back to the roots of agriculture. It only seems natural for the Grange to put the two together."

Packed with 48 raised garden boxes, the new garden occupies what had been a weedy patch at the back of the Grange property, says longtime Orangevale resident Diane Dillard, a garden club veteran who is helping organize the new effort. The boxes are filled with new soil and ready for planting.

"The Grange had a garden years ago, but (nearby) trees got too big and the garden got too much shade," Dillard says. "But this new spot gets lots of sun and is a much more suitable location."

Some of the boxes are elevated for disabled access. Each bed has its own water source, and drip irrigation will be required. Annual lease fee will be \$40; \$35 for Grange members. The lease year will start April 1 each spring.

"There has been a huge response to our outreach to the

community for the garden project," Beilgard says. "Even though the Grange sits on a private piece of property, (the garden) will be open for anyone in the community to lease a garden box per year."

Open to anyone interested, the new Orangevale Grange Farm and Garden Club will be an offshoot of the Grange, which dates back to 1910.

"There are many garden clubs in the (Sacramento) area, however, none in the Orangevale area," Beilgard says. "The garden club will be a part of the Orangevale Grange and will enjoy membership from all. It will have its own committee leaders. There will be an annual participation fee. It will include monthly meetings, monthly speakers, hands-on activities, social events and lifelong learning."

Dillard notes that interest in the new garden club spiked quickly. It attracted 195 followers to its Facebook page in just 10 days after its announcement.

"We asked people what they were interested in, so we could schedule speakers," she says. "The most requested topics: Drip irrigation, vegetable selection, composting, healthy soil, canning and 'what's eating my garden?'"

Beilgard notes that interest in growing food has come back in a big way. That's important to an agriculturally based institution such as the Grange.

"The Orangevale community has a huge - and growing - com-

munity of agriculture," he says. "The local Orangevale-Fair Oaks Food Bank has a 1-acre farm, supplying food to the underserved. Local churches in the area have or are starting their own gar-



dening plots. (That's) along with our awesome farmers market that brings fresh produce and vegetables from our surrounding areas."

The Food Bank Farm hosted a plant sale on Saturday, as well. The Food Bank Farm is next to the Food Bank at 6401 Main Ave., Orangevale.

"They have been assisted by gardeners in the area helping to grow healthy veggie plants for the sale," Dillard says.

Gardeners helping gardeners and farmers helping farmers; that's part of Orangevale's roots, too.

Says Beilgard, "The Grange's vision is to see the farming community awaken once again and make farming and gardening what Orangevale is about."

## LAURA'S LAW IN SACRAMENTO COUNTY

This summer the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors will have a big decision to make regarding whether or not to implement "Laura's Law." I want to take this opportunity in my monthly article to explain to you what this law is, why this is coming before the Board of Supervisors, and why it is such a big deal.

Laura's Law is named for 19-year-old Laura Wilcox, who was a college student working in a Nevada County mental-health clinic in 2001, when she and two others were shot and killed by a man with untreated severe mental illness. After the incident Laura's parents chose to advocate for assisted outpatient treatment (AOT) for individuals who meet strict legal criteria and who, as a result of their mental illness, are unable to voluntarily access community mental health services.

Since then, California counties have the option to "opt in" to the program, and that has been done so far in most of the larger counties. To date, Sacramento County has been one of the few larger counties who has not opted in and has never held a public hearing at the Board of Supervisors regarding whether or not to implement the program.

This process changed however with the passage last year of AB 1976, which requires counties like Sacramento to hold public hearings at the Board of Supervisors about whether we will "opt in" or "opt

out", and if we choose to "opt out" we have to provide specific reasons for this to the State. The deadline for Sacramento County to have this hearing and formally decide will be July 1st of this year.

Earlier this month a mentally ill homeless man assaulted a child on Freeport Blvd. in Sacramento, only to be released back into the public in less than 24 hours – and this was after he had been captured and released previously for assault and battery of another woman. As a former emergency room nurse, I understand firsthand that there are people living in our community who cannot take care of themselves, and they desperately need help.

People like this should be able to get help before more crimes are perpetuated in our communities – it's the compassionate and safe way to move forward. I do not know how I will vote on this issue when it comes before me as I want to have an open ear to both sides as well as be able to fully comprehend the fiscal impacts, but I do know this is a growing problem and we should be handling this problem better than we are right now.

# OV Unplugged

OV UNPLUGGED

Summer has begun and if you haven't seen any pollinators yet; you are not looking hard enough. Did you know that pollinators are not just small flying insects like butterflies and bees?

A pollinator is an animal or insect that visits flowers to drink nectar, eat pollen, and in some cases eat the plant itself. A pollinator can also be a ground animal whom has brushed against a flower thus collecting pollen on its fur or skin. The animal or insect then carries the flower's pollen grains with them as they move around their habitat. Pollinators are vital to our environment to help plants grow fruits, vegetables and nuts. In fact 75-95% of all flowering plants need pollinators. This means that those plants cannot make seeds to reproduce without the help of pollinators. Pollinators, especially insect pollinators, are very important but sadly many have declined in recent years due

to several factors; such as global warming and the use of pesticides.



At Creative Nature Playschool our garden is certified as a Northern American Butterfly Garden, A Monarch Way Station, and a Pollinator Habitat. We use zero pesticides on our property. We also raise and release more than 50 Painted Lady Butterflies each year and highly recommend the experience for families to try at home. As a nature preschool committed to environmental education, we want to protect these pollinators and teach our Playschoolers about their importance. For example when a person sees a bee, there is no reason to flee, just give the bees some space and let them be in their place. In fact our Playschoolers have learned that bees do not want to sting and that if we give bees space we can still observe them pollinating from just a couple feet away. By teaching empathy and respect for these very important creatures we hope to raise the next generation of environmentalists.

In this issue of OV Unplugged we challenge our readers to head outside and find as many pollinators as you can using CNP's Pollinator Scavenger Hunt. This screen-free challenge will help your little ones explore the many wonders of pollinators. When watching bees one might be able to spot the bee's pollen pockets, so look closely. You read that right, bees have 'pockets' on their back legs to help collect the pollen and that's what they want and need, not you.



**CHAMPAGNE BERRY CAKE**

- 1 box of vanilla cake mix
- ½ cup butter, melted
- 1 tsp. almond extract
- 1 (187 ml) mini bottle of champagne (I bought a big bottle and used a little bit more than 6 ounces)
- 2 egg whites

A friend shared a recipe for an easy and delicious cake. This would make a great spring cake for Mother's Day or a great cake for a nice after dinner treat! I think the recipe is originally from the Raley's magazine that they used to give out in the

½ cup fresh blackberries and  
½ cup fresh raspberries- coarsely mashed with a fork  
Powdered sugar

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees and butter a 9-inch round cake pan
2. Beat cake mix, butter, extract and Champagne together in a large bowl. In a medium bowl, beat egg whites until stiff peaks form. (I have a bowl mixer and so I whipped the egg whites mixer first and put into another bowl, then I mixed the cake, butter, extract and Champagne together and then folded the egg whites into the batter. Then, fold in the berries.
3. Pour into prepared pan and bake for 40 minutes or until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean. Let cool before transferring to a serving plate. Dust with powdered sugar.




