Throughout August, the Homeless Assistance Resource Team (HART) of Orangevale and Fair Oaks volunteers were working hard to meet the needs of students in this area. In collaboration with Carmichael HART, over 300 backpacks full of school supplies were delivered to the SJ Unified School District's McKinney-Vento Office to be distributed to school aged kids living in some type of housing transition.

HART's Goal was to fill and deliver 100 backpacks but were able to triple the amount

Orangevale Library grand opening celebration on September 25 Community room to be dedicated in memory of Jane Wise

The public is invited to celebrate the Orangevale Library's reopening with a community celebration and ribbon cutting event on September 25 at noon.

The location's community room will be dedicated in honor of the late Jane Wise, a local community leader and fierce library advocate. Event speakers include Library Director & CEO Rivkah Sass, County Supervisor Sue Frost and Kathleen Eaton.

After a year of renovations, Sacramento Public Library's Orangevale location reopened to the public in August. The \$950,000 renovation made the library fully ADA accessible, and doubled its footprint from 4,320 square feet to 7,910 square feet. The location includes new features to better meet the community's needs with spaces designed for teens and children, two new study rooms, more computers for public use and a new community room. 

SUPPORT NON-PROFITS

A TOT OF MONEY GOING TO NONPROFITS

One of my favorite things to do as a County Supervisor is support local organizations that give back to the community. Nonprofit organizations fill gaps left by government, providing services and supporting cultural growth in a way that is more personal and more direct. Every year that I have been on the Board of Supervisors, we have been able to support the invaluable work of nonprofits with funds generated by the Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT), which comes from guests staying in hotels/motels. Through the TOT Grant Program, the Board of Supervisors awards a million dollars to nonprofits every year to help them enhance their impact on the community. I am thrilled that we are yet again launching the TOT Grant Program for the 2021-2022 cycle and the applications are open! For that reason, I thought that I would use this as an opportunity to increase awareness of the program and encourage as much participation as possible.

Applications are located here: bdm. saccounty.net/TOTGrantProgram Applying organizations are required to be based in Sacramento County and must have specific programs they are requesting to fund. Programs can be for training, events that support tourism, address community issues, or that reach underserved populations. Applications are reviewed and measured by subject area experts and are divided by the subject areas of arts and culture, community development, economic/ workforce development, and health and human services. The more specific applicants can be, the better. The more information about how an organization and program have helped and will continue to help the community, the better. All applications must be submitted online and on time. I want to stress all of those points because we receive so many applications and I want every organization to maximize its chances of receiving funds.

While the total amount of grant funds available is one million dollars, no single organization can receive that much. Grants can be no smaller than \$5,000 and no larger than \$50,000. Additionally, half of the total grant funds is available for the communal competitive pool. The other half is divided among each Su-

pervisor to award to organizations in their district, meaning a minimum of \$100,000 is guaranteed to go to our Supervisorial District 4. I love seeing the organizations in our district submit their proposals and it is never easy to pick who gets funds, but we have always had great successes in each of the communities in our district.

For example, in the past we have been able to secure over \$40,000 for an Orangevale non-profit "About-Kidz", where the funding went to purchase supplies throughout the year to equip children with a fully stocked backpack, new outfit and shoes. We also were able to secure \$10,000 to Community Meal Ministry, where the funds were used to increase the number of guests served at their weekly Orangevale Community Meals. The organiza-

tion also purchased materials to add more garden beds in the community garden and commercial freezers/refrigerators to store additional food.

Applications for the TOT Grant Program are due no later than Monday, October 11th at 5:00 pm. As I mentioned, applications must be submitted online and no late applications will be accepted. The nonprofit organizations of Sacramento County do great work and enhance the quality of life for countless people. Whether your nonprofit organization is seeking to provide school supplies for children, organizing a community clean up, or expanding access to the arts, I encourage you to pull together your team and put together the best application possible. And if you know someone who has a local nonprofit, please send this information to them. The TOT Grant Program is a rare opportunity for us to directly support nonprofit organizations and I hope that many qualified organizations will jump on the opportunity.

Lynne Miles is sharing her recipe for Hoisin-Sauced Pork. It is a super easy recipe for some delicious pork. Her family ate it warm. They ate it cold. They ate it over a salad, over rice and in a sandwich. It was nice to have it cooked and ready to go.

Hoisin-Sauced Pork

2 lbs boneless pork loin roast, (in 1 piece)

Marinade:

- 4 T hoisin sauce
- •1 tsp five-spice powder
- •2 large cloves garlic, crushed and peeled Simmering ingredients:
- •4 T light soy sauce
- •4 quarter-sized slices ginger
- •2 small whole scallions, each cut in 2
- •2 cups boiling water

1.Select a small pot that will accommodate the meat snugly and measure into it the hoisin sauce, then the 5 spice powder and the crushed garlic; mingle well. Roll the meat in the marinade and rub it in well with your fingers. Cover and marinate the meat for at least 4 hours to overnight in the refrigerator.

2.Add the soy sauce, ginger, and scallions to the marinated meat and set the pot over high heat, add the boiling water and stir to mingle. When the liquid comes to a boil, adjust heat to maintain a strong simmering... small

bubbles foaming around the meat... and cover and simmer for 1 hour, turning the meat a few times.

3.Turn off the heat and let the meat steep in the sauce for 15 minutes. Then put both in a bowl, cover and chill in the refrigerator until cold. Scoop off any congealed fat. Slice the meat thin against the grain and serve as it is or with a little of the sauce spooned on top.

Variation: A 2 lb. piece of beef, either rump, loin, or bottom round, may be substituted for the pork roast. Increase the simmering time to 2 hours.

restaurant in Orangevale. They chose Orangevale as they were familiar with the area since they lived near and went to Bella Vista High School in Fair Oaks. They named it La Placita meaning "The Little Plaza" or The Spot. His father was a building contractor who quickly learned how to run the back of the restaurant. Carlos's mother was a waitress and already had some experience running the front area of the restaurant. Carlos and his sister helped run the business which made it a true family affair.

In 2007, Carlos took over running the business when his parents retired. He is grateful for our community which helped make it the success it is. In return, La Placita supports our community in many ways, such as handing out free dinner coupons to recent BV and Casa graduates.


When Covid hit, Carlos stayed positive even though it was quite a challenge. He had to learn to run his business strictly on a 100% "Take Out" basis. During the first three months, his revenue actually increased. He had to add 3 telephone line and incorporate 2 different ways to order online to accommodate all the orders.

Since indoor dining has returned, he has now doubled his staff and hired 6 new employees. Now he is serving 70% dine in and 30% take out. His most popular meal is the "Patrick Burrito" named after a friend of his fathers. It is made with strips of Carne Asada steak, with sautéed tomato, bell pepper, onion and cheese, the plate also comes with rice, beans. Great food and great atmosphere! 


