# IT'S THE GREAT PUMKIN...ORANGEVALE



"Hi, my name is Sankalp I am 12 years old, and I like to garden." This is what I heard when Sankalp, his mother Leele and 3 year old brother introduced themselves to me at the Grand Opening for the Orangevale Grange Community Garden this past April, 2021. Sankalp lives and goes to school in Roseville and has his own Youtube gardening channel called "Green Thumb Gardening". Evidently Sankalp has a passion for gardening and has been gardening since he could walk.

During the tour of the garden project Sankalp proceeded to explain about his newest project, growing a 1000 pound giant pumpkin. He explains how he wanted to grow the pumpkin in his back yard but between the garden boxes he does not have enough room to properly grow that scale of a pumpkin. He shows me a little envelope he had in his pocket of pumpkin seeds he had won in a contest. I showed him a plot of land he could grow his pumpkin and so it began.

Salkalp shows up at the gardens a week later with his dad Raja and they begin to clear out a huge area. Sankalp prepares the soil with an interesting mixer of dirt and nutrients. He explains the art of the mixture and how important it is to get the area cleared for the vines to grow. I'm telling you this kid knows his stuff. Over the course of the growing process, he covers the area with sunscreen material, he snaps off all the male flowers and narrows the pollination down to 1 female flower. He wouldn't allow a bee to pollinate the flower, so he had his own special pollination

Over the course of the summer, he gently places the growing pumpkin on a thick bed of sand, covers the pumpkin to keep from sunburn and uses pool noodles to protect the vines leading to the pumpkin. By this time, about a month in, the pumpkin is reaching 20 lbs. Another month goes by, and it is 100 lbs. Another month it is 200 lbs. He explains that the leaves themselves are 15 pounds in weight. Another month 300 pounds. So far at the end of September and the pumpkin is just south of 500 pounds.

Sankalp will be harvesting his pumpkin and entering it into the "Nut Tree Championship Pumpkin Weighing Contest" on October CONTINUED PAGE 2



Greetings News people--Ray Marchese here to give you an update

on a story brought to you in July 13. Something most people do not know, you are driving down the street and see a person in a bright vest with a stop sign near a school- it must be a school crossing guard.

You are mostly right but up until June 18th of this year the 24 + trained, certified, fingerprinted people that were at assigned locations from Orangevale to Elk Grove were employed by J & J Special Services a Crossing Guard company based in Bakersfield. Some of the individuals had been on the job 10-31 years.

In June the contract was up for renewal and J & J cited Covid as their reason for not putting in a bid or accepting the counties 2-year extension that was offered.

This not only put 25 people out of work but more so put 24 school locations without their School Crossing Guards to safely cross the children coming from and going to school each day. This is something that all of the quards take very seriously. Following the 4 school districts being made aware of the situation that was looming for the rapidly approaching

school year 2 of them did something Elk Grove gave the opportunity to its 9 guards to apply directly with the school district and Twin Rivers was connected with All- Cities- Management (a company based in Las Vegas with a bay area office) who came to an agreement to reinstate the 4 guards to their positions.

A request was put out by San Juan Unified School District & Sacramento City School District for a bid proposal, the response by All- Cities -Management was turned down. San Juan Unified and Sacramento City districts have virtually done nothing.

San Juan Unified / the Dept. of Transportation has had boldly repainted 2 of the crosswalks but no one Trained, Fingerprinted, with a vest and Stop Sign to staff them for pedestrians' safety. The children/ parents walking will do it at their own risk. Do our school children deserve more that the politics we see to safely go to and return home from school?

## THE TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF 9/11 WAS COMMEMORATED BY A FLAG RETIREMENT CEREMONY




represents.


