

And if seen by the children, was surely not right.


The magic of Christmas would last just 12 hours

LOCAL GIRL SCOUT TROOP IS COLLECTING DONATIONS FOR CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL



LORI'S MONKEY BREAD 1-4 pack refrigerated biscuits

½ cup melted butter (1 cube)

1 cup brown sugar Cinnamon/ sugar mixture (3/4 cup sugar and 2 tsp cinnamon)

Spray Bundt pan with non-stick cooking spray. Quarter the biscuits.

Roll/coat the biscuits in the cinnamon/sugar mixture.

Place the pieces in pan. Mix the butter with the brown sugar and then pour over the top of the biscuits in the pan.

Bake at 350 degrees for 30-40 minutes or until browned or when a cake tester comes out clean.

Invert onto plate and serve warm.
