



#### GRILLED JALAPEÑO **CHICKEN**

1/3 cup fresh lime juice 1/4 cup honey 2 tablespoons fresh cilantro leaves 2 tablespoons soy sauce 1/4 tsp salt 1/4 tsp pepper 3 jalapeno peppers, halved and seeded 3 garlic cloves, chopped 6 (6-ounce) skinned bone-in chicken breasts cooking spray

#### LOCAL YOUTH WINS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP TITLE

Alexis Mariscal is 12 years old. She has been training martial arts since she was 5 years old. She initially started in Karate and was a 2x Kumite National Champion. About 4 years ago, Alexis stated training in Judo. Jui Jitsu, and Pankration. This past May, Alexis traveled to Ontario, California and competed in the United States Fight League Pankration Nationals where she placed 2nd and secured her spot to travel and compete in Abu Dhabi at the 2023 IM-MAF Youth World Championships and represent

the United States. The IM-MAF Youth World Championships hosted over 600 athletes from 46 federations making it the biggest celebrations of youth MMA to date.

On August 2nd, Alexis went undefeated and secured wins against India, Italy and a USA teammate making her the 2023 IM-MAF Youth World Champion for the 12-13 girls 115lbs division.

Alexis trains MMA out of Thomas Fallon's Mixed Martial Arts in Citrus Heights. She spends countless hours training and helping train her younger teammates at her gym in addition to training several times a week at Team Maxwell Jiu Jitsu. To prepare for her journey across the world she also cross trained with the Swamp Monsters, a top girls wrestling team out of Califor-






