ORANGEVALE COMMUNITY SWIM-MING POOL GETS A MAKEOVER

Located within the Orangevale Community Center Park, the community swimming pool is a popular attraction and destination during the hot summer months for those looking to cool off. It is also the home of the 4-time defending league champion Orangevale TigerSharks swim team, who this summer also won the 48-team Meet of Champions in the small-teams category. OVparks is also proud that our swim instructors helped 1,026 children learn to swim, or improve upon their swimming skills, this summer.



Our community pool was constructed in 1997 and opened to the public in 1998. The pool was very well designed by taking into consideration the various aquatic activities offered by a public recreation agency. It was also well constructed, with the tile and plaster lasting well beyond what is typical. Pool tile will normally remain in good condition for 15-20 years if installed and maintained properly. Plaster has a wider range of 10-20 years depending on proper chemical balance, maintenance, weather variations, and amount of use. OVparks has been fortunate to get 26 quality summers from this community iewel of a pool, but it is now time to put a new shine on it.

Renovation work began on the pool on September 19 by Burkett's Pool Plastering. The primary work includes: remove and replace all plaster; remove and replace all tile; replace all drain covers; and repair areas of cracking in the pool's floor near the shallow end, which has been a source of leaking in recent years. The renovation work could be completed as soon as November but could extend into January if weather causes delays.

OVparks looks forward to opening our shiny "like new" pool to the community in 2024.

TIME FOR REAL ACTION ON HOMELESSNESS

During my tenure on the Board of Supervisors, I've observed various approaches and strategies addressing the County's homelessness dilemma. In the past I have referred to the age-old concept of "the carrot and the stick" which frequently emerges in conversations about the governance and regulation of the homeless community. At its core, this idea reflects the universal balance we all strike between rules and rewards.

The complexity of this issue increases when considering a segment of our community that is battling mental health challenges and drug-related disorders. Such individuals can lose track of their possessions, remain unaware of their conditions due to "anosognosia," face the harshness of outdoor living, and regrettably, some become targets for nefarious elements within and outside their community.

My recent discussion with the Sheriff's Office brought forth a key insight: the homeless are not an isolated group, but an intrinsic part of our broader community. Their primary distinction is the lack of a fixed address, and the conscious choice to detach from societal norms. This, understandably, presents unique challenges for our tax-paying society. For ex-

ample, how does one monitor parolees without an address?

In the unincorporated areas of the County, the Board of Supervisors addresses these challenges by bridging the divide. Programs such as Navigator outreach, Park Rangers, Sheriff HOT Teams, and sweeps serve to maintain a connection with our homeless community. These operations identify encampments, determine if there are criminal records among inhabitants, combat human trafficking, and shield the most vulnerable. Sheriff Cooper's pragmatic approach to law enforcement underscores a simple truth: the laws exist, they merely need consistent application.

Recently, DA Thien Ho took an unprecedented step, sending a message to the City of Sacramento that reiterates this sentiment. His letter emphasizes the necessity for the City of Sacramento to uphold existing laws, especially concerning the management of the downtown homeless population. The point isn't to demonize, but to highlight the importance of consistent enforcement of laws.

The current policy direction in our state has unfortunately widened the gaps in public safety and how we enforce laws. But a lingering question remains, how much longer do taxpayers have to bear the burden of problems amplified by legislative inaction? This isn't just an abstract statement; it's a call for accountability!

Despite the obstacles, I remain hopeful. With leaders like DA Thien Ho and Sheriff Cooper standing up for justice and law, there's a silver lining. Even in the face of criticism, I hold a positive outlook for our Safe Stay communities. Their mission is to pave the way for treatment and brighter prospects for those who need it most. DA Thien Ho's commitment to tackling Sacramento's homelessness issue signals a tide of change.

His candid criticism of Sacramento City's officials, especially regarding the inconsistent enforcement of rules, such as the encampment-clearing ordinance, resonates with many. A new approach is overdue. Residents of Sacramento, both in the County and City, should reside in a place free from illegal encampments, and most importantly everyone deserves an opportunity for a stable future.

Greenback & Filbert -Hall Ranch

My paternal grandparents, Irving Bertie Hall and wife Della (Clodfelter) Hall built a brick home on Greenback Lane and Filbert Avenue in 1942. My father. Keith Hall lived there while attending San Juan High School. I remember that house just always being there. Dad never said much about it, but he did share two things. When the family was building the swimming pool in the back, the digging got too hard, so grandpa sent dad to Rumsey's (I think that's the right name) Hardware on Bidwell in Folsom of the house when it was being built.

to get some dynamite. They kept it in the basement. The other thing he mentioned was that when his brother-in-law, Merle Trumbull joined the Army Air Corp early in the war, he was stationed at Mc-Clelland Field and buzzed the house in his P-38. A note on the back of a photograph says that brick would not be available until after the war and that grandpa and dad planted the redwood tree in front in 1942. I visited the "office" part of the house a few years ago. It was a stained-glass business – hopefully still is. I sent them the picture I have

My dad, with likely the help of his father and brothers, built this house. It was at the end of a bumpy dirt and gravel one car wide lane. I was born there, rather in Mercy Hospital in Sacramento but came home to this house. I don't recall anything about the inside except the door to my bedroom had a two-part door, one that was split so you could open the top half or the bottom half separately. I just used the bottom half.

I remember it was kind of a medium green with redish I really remember there was a pond outside, surrounded by rose bushes. My dad taught me to ride a small bicycle out there and gave me a push that launched me through the bushes and into the pond.

The Fred Tomich's lived behind us. They had a big old house, and we were kind of in their back orchard. Not sure how that all happened. I do know the parents' names were Paula and Fred and Fred had a twin brother Tom that lived close by. The Tomich property was grand. They also had lots of kids – even one my age Timmy – and a little younger Eric. Paula's voice matched her personality. Unique and vocal

In later years, my dad's construction company (Carmichael Construction) - he was the Vice President, and they built the Divine Savior Catholic Church on Greenback Lane. Tom Tomich's orchard was behind it. My Dad wrote that he stopped to see Tom (to me he always seemed grouchy or sad) and inquired about Fred. Tom said they hadn't spoken in over 20 years. I lost touch with Timmy when we moved away.

Another boy our age, Timmy Storm, lived kind of across the street on Filbert Avenue from the Tom Tomich orchards. The Bacons were close too just off Central on (the Foster Freeze side) and

further down Central, not yet to Main, were the Culbertsons Jimmy and Jerry and my 3rd grade teacher Mrs. Edd. Mrs. Koonz, our librarian, was on the corner of Main & Central. I just remembered she was also Secretary of the Orangevale Chamber of Commerce when dad was president.

I went to Sunday School at the Methodist Church on Central Avenue -the old one that looked like a church that is now a house.



LEMON GLAZED CHEESECAKE

2 cups graham cracker crumbs 6 TBSP melted butter 2 TBSP sugar 3 8-ounce packages cream cheese

¾ cup sugar 3 eggs

¼ cup lemon juice 2 tsp grated lemon rind

2 tsp vanilla

2 cups sour cream 3 TBSP sugar 1 tsp vanilla

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Combine the first 3 ingredients thoroughly. Press crust evenly onto bottom and sides of buttered 9x3 inch springform. Bake 5 minutes, Cool.

Beat cream cheese until soft. Add sugar, blending thoroughly. Add eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition. Mix in lemon juice, rind, and vanilla. Blend well. Turn into springform pan. Bake 35 minutes or until done.

While cake is baking, blend sour cream, sugar and vanilla. Remove cake from oven. Gently spread sour cream mixture over top. Return to oven and bake 12 minutes. Cool on rack for 30 minutes.

Spread with lemon glaze. Chill several hours or overnight before removing sides of pan.

LEMON GLAZE

½ cup sugar
1 ½ TBSP cornstarch
¼ tsp salt
¾ cup water
1/3 cup lemon juice
1 egg yolk
1 TBSP butter
1 tsp grated lemon peel

In a heavy 1-quart saucepan, mix sugar, cornstarch and salt.

Combine water, lemon juice and yolk and add to sugar mixture.

Cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until the mixture comes to a slow boil and is thickened.

Add butter and lemon rind. Allow to cool slightly, but spread on cheesecake before the glaze sets.


